SBM LEVEL OF PRACTICE

TO : All District Supervisors, Elementary and Secondary School Heads
District/School SBM Coordinators, All Concerned,

1. Pursuant to Republic Act 9155, known as Governance of Basic Education Act, and DepEd Order No. 44, s. 2015, School Heads are empowered to make decisions on what is best for the learners they serve. They are mandated to make every school effective that contributes to the attainment of three key result areas:
 - a). Access- that every Filipino has access to complete basic education;
 - b). Quality- that every graduate is prepared for further education and the world of work; and
 - c). Governance - that there is effective, transparent, and collaborative governance of basic education.
2. Anent to this all School Heads are tasked to update the artifacts supporting the Four Principles of School Based Management such as Leadership and Governance, Curriculum and Learning, Accountability and Continuous Improvement, and Management of Resources. All artifacts must be filed properly in conspicuous place accessible to all.
3. In connection with this School Heads are advised to conduct school based assessment of their level of practice using the Revised SBM Assessment Tool (DepEd Order No. 83, s. 2012) considering the following criteria:
 - a). 40% according to the validated practices using the DOD Process:
 - Leadership and Governance -30%,
 - Curriculum and learning - 30%,
 - Accountability and continuous improvement -25% and
 - Management of Resources -15%
 - b). 60% based on improved learning outcomes.
 - Access - 45%, Efficiency - 25% and Quality - 30%.The division shall utilize **school's overall MPS** instead of NAT result for improved learning outcomes.
4. District SBM Coordinators shall send thru sdo.quezon.sbm@gmail.com on August 31, 2017 the summary of SBM Level of Practice of each school in the district.
6. Division Team together with the District Supervisors shall conduct validation of the SBM level of practices starting First week of September.
7. For dissemination and compliance of all concerned.
