To: Public Schools District Supervisors, Coordinating Principals, Elementary/ Secondary Principals, Head Teachers, TICs, OICs (Public and Private), All Concerned

- DepEd Quezon announces the availability of PEPT FORM to be used for the 2018 PEPT Examination.
- 2. The PEPT is under the Accreditation and Equivalency Program (Executive Order No. 733 s. 1981) for retrieving out-of-school youth (OSY) and placing them in the formal school system if they so desire and for validating and accrediting knowledge and skills in academic areas gained through informal and non-formal means for re-entry into formal school, job promotion, entry to job training, for employment and self-fulfillment.
- Interested PEPT applicants will avail and pay Fifty Pesos (Php. 50.00) upon registration. The said payment will be submitted to Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA) afterwards.
- 4. Registration will be open every Friday (8:00 am 5:00 pm) starting December 15, 2017 and will last until January 26, 2018 at DepEd-Quezon, Schools Division Office, Talipan, Pagbilao, Quezon with EPS Luz A. Abusmas in-charge.
