
Pursuant to the Philippine Legislature Act No. 2946, enseted on February 16, 1921, making Nevember 30 of each year a legal heliday to commemorate the birth of Andres Sonifacio, the Department of Education (DepEd) shall celebrate the 156<sup>th</sup> Birth Anniversary of Andres Sonifacio on November 30, 2019.

Relative to this, a commemoration ceremony shall transpire on the above mentioned date, 8:00 a.m., on different sites and venues (see Annex A). DepEd is enjoined to give full support to the commemoration of the said event. The Wreath-Laying ceremonies shall also be repticated in different cities and municipalities nationwide to be spearheaded by their respective local government units (LGUs).

Moreover, all public and private elementary and secondary schools are encouraged to undertake activities that highlight the qualities, achievements and contributions of Andres Bonifacio, the founder of the *Katipunan* and leader of the Philippine Revolution for Independence in 1896.

We also enjoin and encourage that every Region/Division/Schools carry out activities integrated into related subject areas, such as Sibika at Kultura, Heograpiya, Kasaysayan at Sibika (HEKASI), Araling Panlipuman, Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (ESP) Music, Arts, Physical Education and Health (MAPEH), Filipino and English, during classroom discussions to make this year's celebration more meaningful.





Prayel and other incidental expenses to the abovementioned activines shall be charged to local funds, regional/division/school PTCA, School Board Punds and other sources grants, while the travel allowances and per diem of the DepEd Central Office-Technical Working Group (TWG) members shall be charged to the 2019 Building Partnerships & Linkages Program (HPLP) Funds, (AC-19-EPS SEU BPLF-024) subject to its availability, and to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
