DIVISION MEMORANDUM DM No. <u>010</u>, s. 2020

EARLY REGISTRATION FOR SY 2020-2021

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent, SGOD Chief, CID Chief, Elementary and Secondary School Heads, All Others Concerned

- In preparation for the opening of classes for SY 2020-2021, as per Order 3, s. 2018 declares
 January 25, 2019 as the commencement of Early Registration in all public elementary and
 secondary schools in the Division to achieve universal participation and completion of the
 cycles.
- 2. With the support of local officials, civic organizations, people's organizations (POs) and the community, a massive advocacy campaign to find children and youth not currently enrolled and bring them back to school shall be undertaken from January 26 to February 28, 2020.
- 3. The following are the objectives of the Early Registration:
 - a. To ensure that new entrants for Kindergarten, Grades 1, 7, and 11 learners are registered; and
 - b. To locate, identify, and register OSC and OSY in all community who may be characterized as:
 - Living with disability/ies
 - Living in off-grid community
 - Living in a barangay without school
 - Living in a geographically isolated area
 - Displaced due to natural disaster
 - Living in an armed conflict area
 - Living in an area with high level of criminality/drug abuse,
 - Having chronic illness
 - · Having nutritional problem/s
 - Victime of child abuse, economic exploitation
 - Stateless/Undocumented
 - In conflict with the law

Schools are advised to come up with various activities such as house-to-house campaigns or meetings with local and barangay officials, civic organizations and POs to help and locate children who should be in school. Regional offices and school's divisions offices (SDOs) shall support school campaigns. Registration process shall include the following activities:

- 5. Early Registration enrolment data should be encoded and submitted through the <u>Learner Information System Early Registration Tab.</u>
- 6. District Supervisors are advised to monitor the said activity.
- 7. Personnel involved in the conduct of Early Registration during Saturdays/Holidays shall be given service credit as per DepEd Order 53, S. 2003.
- 8. Expenses related to Early Registration shall be charged to school MOOE/local funds, as appropriate and as authorized, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 9. Immediate dissemination and strict compliance with this Memorandum is directed.
