FIRST QUEZON PROVINCE PRIVATE SCHOOL EDUCATORS' CONVENTION

To: All Private Schools Owners and Administrators

1. The United Private Educational Institutions of Quezon, Inc. (UPEIQ, Inc.), formerly QUEPPRISA, Inc., will be celebrating its 20th year Anniversary in SY 2018-2019. One of the highlights of this milestone is the **First Quezon Province Private School Educators' Convention** which will be held on December 5, 2018 at the Quezon Convention Center, Lucena City with the theme, **"UPEIQ @20: Thriving in an Era of Innovation and Empowerment"**.
2. The convention aims to:
 - a. provide the latest educational developments for the professional judgment of educators in determining their needs for innovation and empowerment;
 - b. motivate teachers, coordinators, principals, administrators and school leaders to explore, think critically and reflect on their professional practice to identify action strategies and solutions for issues of common concern;
 - c. disseminate information and updates on DepEd Orders and Memorandums concerning private schools;
 - d. provide a better avenue for promoting camaraderie among the members of the association.
3. Participants to this convention are Private School Owners, Administrators, Principals, and School Heads, Teachers (Pre-School, Elem, JHS, SHS) and Private School Staff of the Division of Quezon. Each delegation is advised to wear their most comfortable school/event uniform and expected to occupy the designated areas for their schools/congressional districts during the program.
4. A registration fee of two hundred fifty pesos (250.00) shall be charged each participant for meals (AM Snacks, Lunch, & PM Snacks). Pre-registration of attendees shall be done via googleDocs/Forms (posted link in the FB Group). Registration starts at 7:00 AM and Convention proper is from 8:30 A.M to 5:00 PM.
5. Classes in all private schools of the Division of Quezon are suspended on December 5, 2018. However, make-up classes shall be held in lieu of the one-day cancellation of classes.
