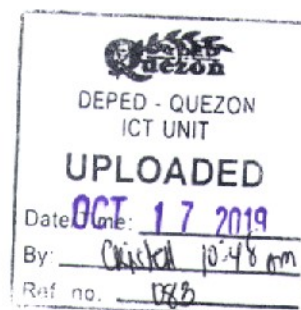

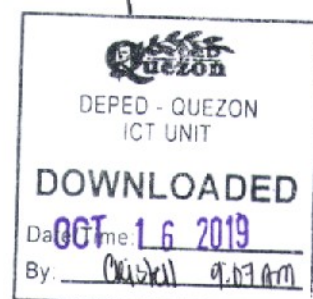

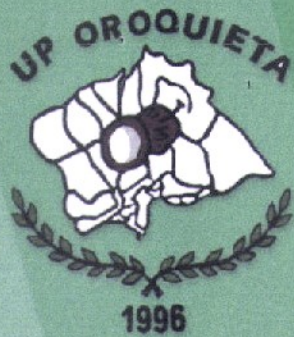

23rd Intellectual's Quiz

Objectives

- To promote academic excellence among junior and senior high school students in Quezon Province;
- To foster and enhance camaraderie and sportsmanship among the participating schools in Quezon Province; and
- To nurture the sense of nationalism of the youth today.

Mechanics

General Guidelines

1. This event is open to all junior high school students currently enrolled in educational institutions in Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Quezon Province which are recognized by the Department of Education (DepEd), who may form a team of **four (4)** members to represent their school in the Quiz Contest. Only one (1) team per school shall be allowed to join.
2. All participants are expected to come at 7:30 in the morning for the registration. The Opening Program will start at 9:00 in the morning.
3. The 23rd IQ will feature seven events for junior high school as follows: Quiz Contest, Essay-Writing Contest, Poster-Making Contest, Slogan-Making Contest, Impromptu Speaking Contest, Literary (Poetry-Writing) Contest and Photo Essay Contest.
4. The morning session will consist of the following simultaneous events: Impromptu Speaking Contest, Essay-Writing Contest, Poster-Making Contest, Slogan Making Contest, Literary (Poetry-Writing) Contest and Photo Essay Contest. These activities will commence at 10:00 in the morning and will end at 12:00 noon. The afternoon session will start at 1:00 pm and will end at 5:00 pm. The afternoon events include the Quiz Contest, Awarding Ceremony, and the Closing Program.

Registration



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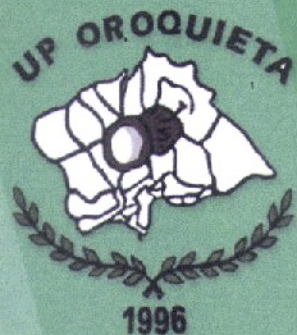
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1. Each team shall submit a registration form provided by the staff, and must be sent to uporoquieta96@gmail.com. Deadline for submission is on **November 22, 2019 (Friday)**.
2. A registration fee shall be collected with an amount of **Php 250** per team for the Quiz Contest. For individual competitions, excluding the Photoessay Contest, an amount of **Php 100** will be collected for each participant. For Photoessay Contest participants, a **Php 150** will be collected for each.
3. Walk-in schools or those who submitted a registration form later than the said date will correspond to a higher registration fee of **Php 280** per team for the Quiz Contest, and **Php 120** for the individual contests except for Photoessay Contest participants. Walk-in participants for Photoessay Contest shall have a registration fee of **Php 180**.
4. All participants are expected to come at the venue at 7:30 in the morning for the registration. Student IDs must be presented upon registration.

QUIZ CONTEST

Elimination Round

1. Each team must be well-rounded enough in **ALL** the four (4) major categories: **Mathematics** (Algebra, Business Math, Geometry, Statistics and Calculus); **Science** (Earth Science, Biology, Chemistry and Physics); **Social Studies** (Philippine, Asian and World History, Economics, and Population Education); and **General Information** (Culture, Arts, Literature, Music, Sports, People, Places and Entertainment).
2. The mechanics of the elimination round are formed to test the well-roundedness of each participant. Each contestant will be given a corresponding number (1, 2, 3, and 4) at the start of the quiz contest. The proctors of each team shall be the ones to assign their corresponding numbers. Once the numbers were placed on each contestant in the team, they are not allowed to exchange numbers with their teammates.
 - a. Before each question, a random number will be drawn and the contestant assigned to that number shall be the representative that will answer the question.
 - b. A school will then be randomly picked, and a representative from the chosen school shall be the one to declare the category he/she wants for that specific question. This will take turns until all teams are called; thus, giving equal chances of choosing a category. This is called the **complete turn**.
 - c. Since there are a total of **sixty (60)** questions for this round (levels are not in order), the number of complete turns will be based on the number of schools



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participated. If the remaining number of questions from the total of sixty (60) will not meet the complete turn, the quizmaster(s) will be the one to pick the category on each of the remaining questions until the end of the elimination round.

3. The questions for the elimination round shall be taken from the four (4) categories stated above. The elimination round will consist of shuffled easy, average and difficult round and shall have 20 questions each.

4. The questions shall be dictated by the Quiz Master(s), and the contestants must enter/ write their answers in the boards provided before the time is up.
5. The teams are allowed to answer once the Quiz Master(s) start(s) to read the question. The time starts after the question has been read twice.
6. The four (4) categories will be shown on the screen. Questions shall be flashed on the screen as well as the time remaining to answer. All numerical answers must be expressed in accordance with the rule of significant figures unless stated otherwise. Answers in word form must be in their correct spellings and proper capitalization. Proper names of people shall be written in full name e.g. first and last names; initials will not be accepted. The same follows for questions requiring dates and places. If the answer being asked is a scientific name, it should be written in its proper form, underlined for both genus and species.
7. A panel of judges shall be present during the competition.



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- a. The judges will address all of the concerns, as well as protests raised by the participants.
 - b. Decisions made by the judges are considered as final and irrevocable.
 - c. Only the coaches and the contestants are allowed to file a protest. All protests shall be raised before the next question is read; protests read at a later time shall not be entertained.
8. Substitution of players who are not registered as the four (4) official delegates are not allowed. Should there be any replacements of delegates for the quiz contest due to unforeseen event e.g. sickness, death of relatives, among others, the staff and organizers must be informed immediately.
 9. The five teams who have the highest scores shall proceed to the final round of the competition. In case of ties, there will be a clincher round in a form of sudden death format.
 10. All questions must be answered in 10 seconds unless specified.

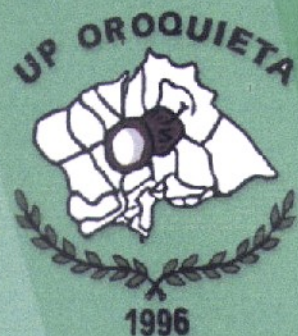
Final Round

1. The five teams who have the highest scores shall proceed to the final round of the competition.
2. In case of a tie, a tie breaking question will be asked. Final scores will determine the Quiz Contest's champion.
- Note: Mechanics for the Final Round will be given during the contest proper.

Winners

1. The team with the highest points at the end of this round shall be named as this year's Quiz Show Champion.
2. The Top 3 teams shall receive a trophy, certificates and cash prizes. The Champion will receive three thousand pesos (PhP 3,000), the 1st Runner-Up will receive two thousand pesos (PhP 2,000) and the 2nd Runner-Up will receive one thousand pesos (PhP 1,000).

Disqualification



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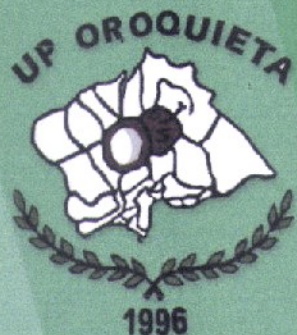
Disqualification may be imposed upon teams due to, but is not limited to, the following:

1. Any misrepresentation in the registration documents;
2. Commission of behavioral violation, outright violation of rules and regulations of the vent, or any act committed against the applicable laws; and
3. Cheating.

ESSAY WRITING CONTEST

1. The theme for the on-the-spot essay writing contest will be announced during the contest proper.
2. All entries must contain a minimum of 500 words. The papers that will be used by the participants shall be provided by the members of UP OROQUIETA. Only the papers provided by UP OROQUIETA during the conduct of the contest shall be considered official.
3. A maximum of two (2) participants per school will be allowed to join the contest.
4. **English or Filipino** language will be used.
5. Participants will be given two (2) hours to finish their entry. A facilitator-in-charge will be assigned to provide the papers on the beginning of the competition and to collect them after the participants have finished their entry. Proctors will also be designated to assist the needs of the participants.
6. Each entry will be given a numerical code to secure impartiality and secrecy before it is submitted to the Board of Judges.
7. The essays will be judged according to the following criteria:

a. Content and Relevance to the Topic	40%
b. Organization and Development of the Idea	30%
c. Style	15%
d. Use of Words and Proper Grammar	<u>15%</u>
	100%
8. There will be two members of the Board of Judges for the essay writing and their decision is considered final and irrevocable.
9. The three entries that will get the highest percentage shall be declared as the Champion, 1st Runner-up and 2nd Runner-up respectively. The top three participants will be receiving medals and certificates.



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POSTER MAKING CONTEST

1. The theme for the on-the-spot poster making contest will be announced during the contest proper.
2. Participants are only allowed to use oil pastels, crayons, ball pens, and pencils as their medium. Only the canvas (1/4 illustration board) will be provided by the UP OROQUIETA.
3. A maximum of two (2) participants per school will be allowed to join the contest.
4. Participants will be given two hours to finish their entry. A facilitator-in-charge will be assigned to provide the canvas on the beginning of the competition and to collect them after the participants have finished their entry. Proctors will also be designated to assist the needs of the participants.
5. Each entry will be given a numerical code to secure impartiality and secrecy before it is submitted to the Board of Judges.
6. The posters will be judged according to the following criteria:

a. Originality	20%
b. Relevance to the Topic	30%
c. Creativity	30%
d. Overall Appeal	<u>20%</u>
	100%
7. There will be two members of the Board of Judges for the poster making contest and their decision is final and irrevocable.
8. The three entries that will get the highest percentage shall be declared as the Champion, 1st Runner-up and 2nd Runner-up respectively. The top three participants will be receiving medals and certificates.

SLOGAN-MAKING CONTEST

1. The theme for the on-the-spot slogan-making contest will be announced during the contest proper.
2. Each slogan should have 10-15 (Medium) words.
3. A maximum of two (2) participants per school will be allowed to join the contest.
4. **English or Tagalog** language will be used.



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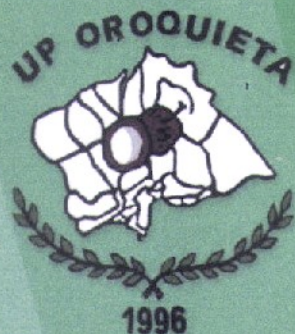
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5. The participant is required to bring his/her own materials except for the cartolina. Coloring materials are not allowed except for markers of any color.
6. Participants will be given one (1) hour to finish their entry. A facilitator-in-charge will be assigned to provide the cartolina on the beginning of the competition and to collect them after the participants have finished their entry. Proctors will also be designated to assist the needs of the participants.
7. The output should not contain any drawing or design such as borders and the likes.
8. Each entry will be given a numerical code to secure impartiality and secrecy before it is submitted to the Board of Judges.
9. The slogans will be judged according to the following criteria:

a. Relevance to the Theme	30%
b. Creativity	30%
c. Originality	20%
d. Overall Appeal	<u>20%</u>
	100%
10. There will be two members of the Board of Judges for the slogan-making and their decision is considered final and irrevocable.
11. The three entries that will get the highest percentage shall be declared as the Champion, 1st Runner-up and 2nd Runner-up respectively. The top three participants will be receiving medals and certificates.

LITERARY (POETRY WRITING) CONTEST

1. The theme for the on-the-spot literary (poetry writing) contest will be announced during the contest proper.
2. **English or Tagalog** language will be used.
3. A maximum of two (2) participants per school will be allowed to join the contest.
4. Participants will be given one (1) hour to finish their entry. A facilitator-in-charge will be assigned to provide the papers, where the composition will be written, on the beginning of the competition and to collect them after the participants have finished their entry. Proctors will also be designated to assist the needs of the participants.
5. Each entry will be given a numerical code to secure impartiality and secrecy before it is submitted to the Board of Judges.
6. The slogans will be judged according to the following criteria:



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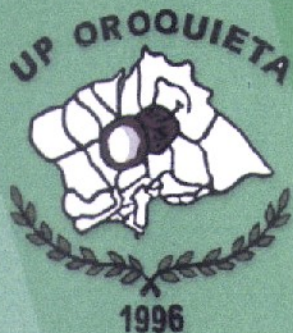

7. There will be two members of the Board of Judges for the literary (poetry writing) and their decision is considered final and irrevocable.
 8. The three entries that will get the highest percentage shall be declared as the Champion, 1st Runner-up and 2nd Runner-up respectively. The top three participants will be receiving medals and certificates.

IMPROMPTU SPEAKING CONTEST

1. Only one topic will be given to all the contestants.
2. Only one (1) participant per school will be allowed to join the contest.
3. Participants will have a two-minute period for the preparation of the speech and a maximum of three minutes for the delivery. **Five (5) points** will be deducted from the score for every **15 seconds** over the three-minute limit.
4. The rest of the participants are not allowed to see their contenders when they deliver their speeches. Students are not allowed to confer with their mentors regarding the topic they would talk about.
5. No paper, note cards or pre-written speeches will be allowed.
6. **English or Tagalog** language will be used.
7. The speeches will be judged according to the following criteria:

a. Speech Development (Contents, Relevance to the topic)	35%
b. Use of Language (Sentence Construction, Grammar, Use of Words)	25%
c. Delivery (Gestures, Spontaneity)	20%
d. Overall Appeal	15%
e. Audience Impact	<u>5%</u>
	100%
8. There will be two members of the Board of Judges for the Impromptu Speaking and their decision is considered final and irrevocable.
9. The three speakers who will get the highest percentage shall be declared as the Champion, 1st Runner-up and 2nd Runner-up respectively. The top three participants will be receiving medals and certificates.



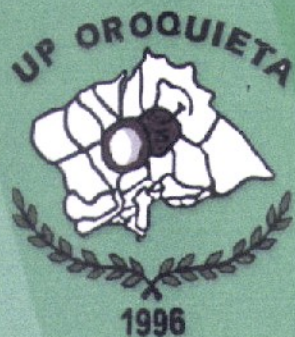
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PHOTO ESSAY CONTEST

1. Only one (1) participant per school will be allowed to join the contest.
2. The topic will be given on-the-spot.
3. A **DSLR camera** should be provided by each participant. A kit lens (18-55 mm) shall be used. The camera must be set into manual setting. Pic style and auto white balance are not allowed.
4. The contest will start immediately after the Opening Program.
5. Each participant will be asked to **delete all the contents of their camera's memory card** before taking pictures.
6. **All participants are strictly limited to take only fifteen (15) shots with their cameras. A participant who deletes a picture will be disqualified.**
7. Participants will be sent to a venue wherein they will be tasked to shoot pictures for one (1) hour only.
8. Participants will only choose seven (7) out of their fifteen shots. Soft copies of the pictures must be submitted before printing.
9. Participants will be asked to layout the pictures in a provided 10" by 15" cartolina.
10. Each participant should provide a title not exceeding ten words (**English or Tagalog**).
11. The photo essays will be judged based from the following criteria:

a. Relevance to the theme	40%
b. Technical Excellence	30%
c. Artistic Merit	<u>30%</u>
	100%
12. The three entries that will get the highest percentage shall be declared as the Champion, 1st Runner-up and 2nd Runner-up respectively. The top three participants will be receiving medals and certificates.



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OVERALL WINNERS

1. A perpetual trophy will be given to the school who will be the Overall Champion for this year's 23rd Intellectual's Quiz.
2. The point system for the Overall Champion will be as follows:

1. PALAISIPAN will be launched to test the academic excellence and well-roundedness among high school students from various provinces in the Philippines. PALAISIPAN shall be held at University of the Philippines Los Baños (UPLB) on March, 2019.
2. The **Champions** from all the seven (7) events namely: Quiz Contest, Essay-Writing Contest, Poster-Making Contest, Slogan-Making Contest, Impromptu Speaking Contest, Literary (Poetry-Writing) Contest and Photo Essay are all bound to the national level.
3. The mechanics and guidelines for PALAISIPAN will be introduced to the winners at the end of IQ. Meaning, there will be a short briefing for the new team together with their respective coaches to be facilitated by some members of UP Oroquieta.

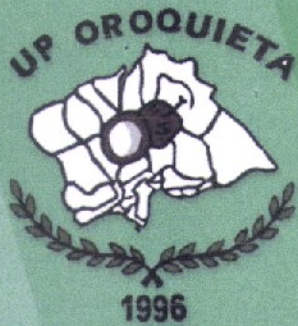
Mechanics

General Guidelines

1. All participants are expected to come at 7:30 in the morning for the registration. The Opening Program will start at 9:00 in the morning.
2. The 23rd IQ will feature two events for senior high school namely (1) IQ Debate Competition and (2) IQ Business Plan Competition.
3. The IQ Business Plan Competition will commence at 10:00 in the morning, after the opening program and will end at 5:00 in the afternoon while the IQ Debate Competition will commence at 1:00 in the afternoon and will end at 5:00 in the afternoon. Awarding Ceremony and Closing program will be held at 5:00 in the afternoon.

Registration

1. Each team shall submit a registration form provided by the staff, and must be sent to uporoquieta96@gmail.com. Deadline for submission is on **November 22, 2019 (Friday)**.
2. A registration fee shall be collected with an amount of **Php 150** for both the Debate and Business Plan Competition.



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3. All participants are expected to come at the venue at 7:30 in the morning for the registration. Student IDs must be presented upon registration.

IQ DEBATE COMPETITION

IQ Debate Competition aims to expose senior high students to situations similar to the actual practice in the field of business in terms of making rational decisions. It tends to encourage innovative analysis and interpretation in order to boost the confidence and critical thinking of students.

QUALIFICATIONS:

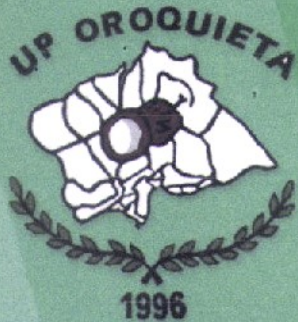
1. The IQ Debate competition is open for all bonafide senior high students enrolled in any school in Quezon Province.
2. Each school may send up to 2 teams. Each team shall be comprised of **three (3)** members.
3. Change of contestant/s or substitution shall be **ALLOWED**, provided that they shall submit all requirements (soft copy) for the new representative/s **at least 1 week before the competition proper**.
4. Walk-ins shall NOT be allowed to participate in the competition.

COVERAGE:

It shall cover any business and socio-political related issues or motions that concern Quezon, Province. Topics will be given a week before the competition to the registered participants.

GENERAL COMPETITION RULES AND MECHANICS:

1. Contestants should be in their assigned rooms 10 minutes before the start of the competition.
2. Late teams shall be allowed to join the competition. However, they are not to be given extended time to finish their preparation to compete with other teams.
3. Contestants are encouraged to wear their corporate attire during the competition.



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4. In case one or two members of the group cannot participate, given with an acceptable excuse, only the remaining contestant/s shall be allowed to represent their school.
5. The contestants shall not be allowed to bring anything except their writing materials and a laptop for each team.
6. Each team shall be allowed to bring their laptop for the competition. Contestants shall be strictly prohibited from opening other application besides the following:
 - a. MS Word, MS Excel, MS PowerPoint
7. Any contestant caught cheating shall automatically be disqualified along with their teammates from the competition.
8. All queries, clarifications, question and/or protests shall be addressed to the organizing team or board of judges. The decision of the organizing committee and the board of judges shall be final and irrevocable.

CONTEST PROPER MECHANICS

1. The competition will adapt a round robin system. The team with the highest point will be held as the winning team. In case if the highest score is tied up by two teams, a clincher round will be conducted to give an extra point to the winning team.
2. British Parliamentary debate will be adapted as the style of the competition. Each debate will be composed of two Side namely, Government and Opposition. The Government will be composed of the Prime Minister, Deputy Prime Minister, Government Whip as speakers. While, The Opposition will be composed of the Leader of Opposition, Deputy Leader of the Opposition, and Opposition whip.
3. Each team shall be given 30 minutes to prepare for the debate.
4. Each speaker will be given 7 to 10 minutes for their rebuttals and defend their side of the motion.
5. The criteria for judging are as follows:



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Content & Logic	25%
Analyses	15%
Rebuttals	15%
Presentation	25%
Teamwork	<u>20%</u>
Total	100%

6. The decision of the board of judges shall be final and irrevocable.

Awards and Recognition

The 1st Place team will receive customized medals for each member of the Champion Team plus a Team Certificate for their school. The 1st Runner-up and 2nd Runner-up Team members will also be given customized medals, respectively and also Team Certificates. Certificate of Participation will be given to all participating schools.

Corresponding CASH PRIZES will also be given to the winners of the competition.

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IQ BUSINESS PLAN COMPETITION

YVB Case Study Competition aims to expose senior high students to situations similar to the actual practice in field business and promotes that originates from the province. It tends to encourage innovative analysis and interpretation in order to boost the creativity and critical thinking of students.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. The IQ Business Plan competition is open for all senior high students, students from the ABM strand are highly encouraged, enrolled in any school of Quezon Province.



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2. Each college/university may send up to 2 teams. Each team shall be comprised of **three (3)** members.
3. Change of contestant/s or substitution shall be **ALLOWED**, provided that they shall submit all requirements (soft copy) for the new representative/s **at least 1 week before the competition proper**.
4. Walk-ins shall NOT be allowed to participate in the competition.

COVERAGE:

Any business plan that will promote products and resources from Quezon Province will be accepted.

GENERAL COMPETITION RULES AND MECHANICS:

1. Contestants should be in their assigned rooms 10 minutes before the start of the competition.
2. Late teams shall be allowed to join the competition. However, they are not to be given extended time to finish their case analysis.
3. Contestants are encouraged to wear their corporate attire during the competition.
4. In case one or two members of the group cannot participate, only the remaining contestant/s shall be allowed to represent their school.
5. Each team will be required to bring a poster (3x5 ft.) of their business plan.
6. The contestants shall not be allowed to bring anything except their Business Plan poster, laptop, and product (if a tangible sample can be presented).
7. Each team shall be allowed to bring their laptop for the competition. Contestants shall be strictly prohibited from opening other application besides the following:
 - a. MS Word, MS Excel, MS PowerPoint



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8. Any contestant caught cheating shall automatically be disqualified along with their teammates from the competition.
9. All queries, clarifications, question and/or protests shall be addressed to the organizing team or board of judges. The decision of the organizing committee and the board of judges shall be final and irrevocable.

CONTEST PROPER MECHANICS

1. Each team shall be given an hour to prepare for their business plan presentation.
2. Each team will be given 20 minutes to present their case business. Within the time allotted per team, it shall include the following: 10 minutes presentation and 5 to 10 minutes to accommodate the questions and inquiries from the board of judges.
3. The criteria for judging are will be based on the grading rubric attached to this document. Each team can get an at most of 4 points for each criterion and can accumulate to a maximum of 48 points for the whole criteria.
4. The decision of the board of judges shall be final and irrevocable.

Awards and Recognition

The 1st Place team will receive customized medals for each member of the Champion Team plus a Team Certificate for their school. The 1st Runner-up and 2nd Runner-up Team members will be given customized medals, respectively and also Team Certificates. Certificate of Participation will be given to all participating schools.

Corresponding CASH PRIZES will also be given to the winners of the competition.
