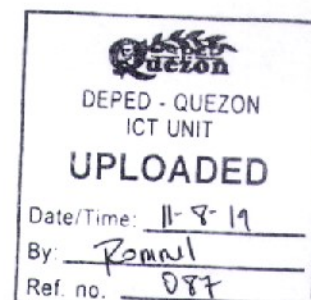

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

**The 2019 ACADEMIC QUIZ BEE FOR ELEMENTARY, JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL
& SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL IN THE DIVISION OF QUEZON**

To : All Private School Administrators, Principals and School heads

1. In order to showcase the competencies of Private Elementary, Junior High School and Senior High School students in the Division of Quezon, the United Private Educational Institutions of Quezon, Inc. (UPEIQ) will be conducting the 2019 Academic Quiz Bee. This will be held on November 9, 2019 at MSEUF Gymnasium, Candelaria, Quezon.
2. Participants are enrolled students of the Private Schools in the Division of Quezon for the School year 2019-2020 and an active member of UPEIQ and NAPSPHIL to qualify in the Regional Level. Each participating school will field a team of three (3) students per category from the following grade levels:
 - a. 3 Participants (Elementary) 1 student- Grade 4, 1 student -Grade 5 and 1 student-Grade 6 per category
 - b. 3 Participants (JHS) 1 student- Grade 7, 1 student -Grade 8, 1 student- Grade 9 and 1 student-Grade 10 per category
 - c. 1 student per category for Senior High School (1- Current Events, 1- Spelling)
3. The contest covers the following:
 - a. Science (Elem/ JHS)
 - b. Math (Elem/JHS)
 - c. Araling Panlipunan (Elem/ JHS)
 - d. Spelling / Current Events (SHS)
4. On Line Registration is a MUST! Walk-in Registration is not allowed. A minimal Registration Fee of One hundred fifty pesos (P150.00) shall be charged each participant to cover expenses during the event. Deadline of Registration will be on November 7, 2019, 5pm
5. Registration starts at 7:00 AM and Contest commences at 8:00A.M.
6. Immediate and wide dissemination and compliance of this memorandum is earnestly desired.

SCHOOL YEAR 2019 - 2020

GENERAL GUIDELINES

A. PRE-CONTEST PROPER:

1. Only UPEIQ member-schools and/or NAPSPHIL member schools are qualified to participate in the contests. Member schools are those who are active and have paid their institutional fees.
2. Contestants must be bona fide students of the school they represent.
3. For Intermediate and Junior High School Levels, there will be four (4) subject areas: SCIENCE, MATHEMATICS, ARLING PANLIPUNAN and SPELLING.
4. Contestants in all events should be organized in teams:
 - a. Three (3) members for intermediate [Grade 4 (1), Grade 5 (1), & Grade 6 (1)];
 - b. Four (4) members for Junior High School [Grade 7 (1), Grade 8 (1), Grade 9 (1) and Grade 10 (1)].
5. For Senior High School, there will be two (2) categories: SPELLING and CURRENT EVENTS. There should be one (1) student for each contest.
6. A contestant is allowed to join one contest only. Reserved student is not allowed.
7. For Intermediate and Junior High School, a team is automatically disqualified if only one member is present.
8. Each team must have a leader and an official coach.
9. Each team must submit the following on or before **November 9, 2019** at Division Office or at the Venue:
 - a) **photocopy of the contestant's I.D.; and**
 - b) **certificate of enrollment signed by the official coach and school principal.**
 - c) **Registration fee: P150.00 per student**
 - d) **There will be a fine of P1,500.00 FOR EACH ENTRY in addition to the registration fee when the school REGISTERED ON LINE and failed to SHOW-UP during the competition.**
10. Failure to abide by the general guidelines means disqualification.
11. Coaches and contestants are expected to:
 - a. Wear appropriate attire: school uniform and ID are not allowed;
 - b. Bring 1/8 size white board, writing instrument and eraser
(Scratch paper will be provided by the organizers);
 - c. Be identified by an assigned number and not by the name of the school they represent; and
 - d. Prohibit them from having consultations during the contest proper.

B. CONTEST SCHEDULE:

DIVISION Academic Competitions will be held on November 9, 2019 at **Manuel S. Enverga University-Candelaria** while REGIONAL Competitions will be held in Hotel Dominic, Tagaytay City

8:00	- Opening Ceremony
9:00	- Registration (Junior and Senior High School)

- First Part: Elementary Level

- -Spelling/Araling Panlipunan/ Science/Mathematics

- Second Part: Junior High School & Senior High School Levels

- Contest Proper (Simultaneous- JHS and SHS)
- Spelling/Araling Panlipunan Science/Mathematics/ (JHS)
- Spelling and Current Events (Senior High School)



C. CONTEST PROPER:

1. A grace period of 5 minutes will be given to each team. If the team fails to show up after 5 minutes, the team/contestant will automatically be disqualified from joining the contest.
2. Use of calculators or other electronic devices will not be allowed.
3. Cheating in any form will not be tolerated. This is a ground for disqualification.
4. All questions have been prepared by a team of external specialists.
5. During the contest proper, contestants are expected to:
 - a. Be on their designated seats;
 - b. Place their team number on the upper right hand corner of the white board
(The number will be determined based on the registration.); and
 - c. Confer with one another in a moderate voice.
6. The quizmaster must do the following:
 - a. Announce the allotted time for each round;
 - b. Read the question twice;
 - c. Instruct contestants to answer only after he/she says any of these words:
 - i. "GO", "START", "BEGIN";
 - d. Declare answer as "CORRECT" or "WRONG"; and
 - e. break the tie by giving clincher question/s ("knock-out" system will be used).
7. In case of problem solving in Mathematics and Science, jotting down of facts may be done after the first reading.
8. A buzzer signals the end of the allotted time.
9. The white board will be raised by the team leader for checking. Answers must be written legibly, in lowest / simplest term, spelled correctly, with accurate units when needed. Answers will be considered wrong if these instructions are not followed.
10. Unless the item calls for multiple answers, the contestant should write only one answer.
11. Two official scorers will record the points in their respective tally board/sheet. The tally board will be visible to the audience.
12. Complaints/Questions by the team leader or coach must be raised before the next question is given.
13. The decision of the quizmaster is final and irrevocable.
14. Medals will be awarded to winners.

D. SCOPE:

1. All questions for MATHEMATICS, SCIENCE and ARLING PANLIPUNAN shall be **based on K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum** for Intermediate and Junior High School.
2. **SPELLING (All Levels)**
 - a. Spelling words are limited to common English words.
 - b. The American English spelling system of Webster's Dictionary shall be followed.
 - c. No foreign derivation and scientific terms will be included. Regardless of the position in the sentence, all common nouns should be written in small letters while proper nouns should start with capital letters.
3. **CURRENT EVENTS**
 - a) Current Events will cover local (Philippines) news from May 2019 to present.
(Intermediate & Junior High School)
 - b) Current Events will cover local (Philippines) and international news from May 2019 to present. (Senior High School)

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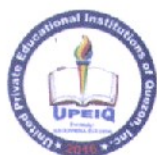
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4. ARALING PANLIPUNAN

- a. Philippine History (*Intermediate*)
- b. Asian History, World History, Economics (*Junior High School*)

MECHANICS FOR SCIENCE

[Intermediate Level]

- Easy** : 5 questions for 1 point each (*Multiple Choice*)
Five (5) seconds will be allotted for each question
- Average** : Five (5) questions for 2 points each (*Identification*)
Ten (10) seconds will be allotted for each question
- Difficult** : Five (5) questions for 3 points each (*Identification or Problem Solving*)
Fifteen (15) seconds will be allotted for Identification
Forty (40) seconds will be allotted for Problem Solving

MECHANICS FOR SCIENCE

[Junior High School Level]

- Easy** : Five (5) questions for 1 point each
Five (5) seconds will be allotted for each question (*Multiple Choice*)
2 questions - Science 1
1 question - Biology
1 question - Chemistry
1 question - Physics
- Average**: Five (5) questions for 2 points each (*Identification*)
Ten (10) seconds will be allotted for each question
2 questions - Science 1
1 question - Biology
1 question - Chemistry
1 question - Physics
- Difficult** : Five (5) questions for 3 points each (*Problem Solving*)
Forty (40) seconds will be allotted for each question
2 questions - Chemistry
3 questions - Physics

MECHANICS FOR MATHEMATICS

[Intermediate Level]

- Easy** : Five (5) questions for 1 point each
: Ten (10) seconds will be allotted for each question (*Multiple Choice*)
- Average** : Five (5) questions for 2 points each
:Thirty (30) seconds will be allotted for each question
(*Identification or Problem Solving*)
- Difficult** : Five (5) questions for 3 points each (*Problem Solving*)
: One (1) minute will be allotted for each question

[Junior High School Level]

- Easy** : Five(5) questions for 1 point each
: Ten (10) seconds will be allotted for each question (*Multiple Choice*)
2 questions - Algebra
1 question - Geometry
1 question - Trigonometry
1 question - Statistics and Probability

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Average : Five (5) questions for 2 points each.
: Thirty (30) seconds will be allotted for each question
(Identification or Problem Solving)
2 questions - Algebra
1 question - Geometry
1 question - Trigonometry
1 question - Statistics and Probability

Difficult : Five (5) questions for 3 points each.
: One (1) minute will be allotted for each question (Problem Solving)
2 questions - Algebra
1 question - Geometry
1 question - Trigonometry
1 question - Statistics and Probability

MECHANICS FOR ARLING PANLIPUNAN

[Intermediate and Junior High School Levels]

Questions and answers should be written in FILIPINO.

Easy : Five (5) questions for 1 point each
: Five (5) seconds will be allotted for each question (Multiple Choice)

Average: Five (5) questions for 2 points each
Ten (10) seconds will be allotted for each question (Identification)

Difficult : Five (5) questions for 3 points each
: Fifteen (15) seconds will be allotted for each question (Identification)

MECHANICS ON SPELLING

[Intermediate, Junior and Senior High School Levels]

Easy : Five (5) questions for 1 point each
: Five (5) seconds will be allotted for each question

Average: Five (5) questions for 2 points each
Ten (10) seconds will be allotted for each question

Difficult : Five (5) questions for 3 points each
: Fifteen (15) seconds will be allotted for each question

- All action words must be spelled in the present tense.
- Proper syllabication must be observed.
- The words will have diacritical marks for pronunciation, part of speech, meaning and usage in a sentence.

MECHANICS ON CURRENT EVENTS

[Senior High School Level]

Easy : Five (5) questions for 1 point each
: Five (5) seconds will be allotted for each question (Multiple Choice)

Average: Five (5) questions for 2 points each
Ten (10) seconds will be allotted for each question (Identification)

Difficult : Five (5) questions for 3 points each
: Fifteen (15) seconds will be allotted for each question (Identification)
