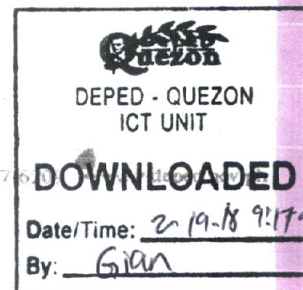
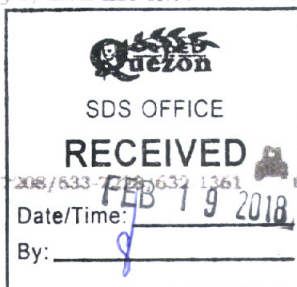
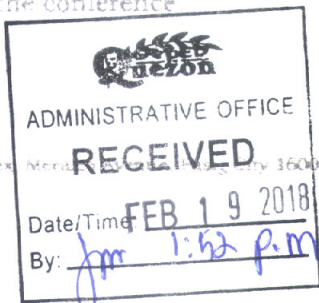
2. The Conference aims to:
