

Dear Director Rocafort:

A Special Audit Team (SAT) from the Fraud Audit Office, Special Services Sector, Commission on Audit, Quezon City, is conducting its fraud audit/investigation relative to the abovementioned subject. The school principal/head teacher shall swear under oath the truthfulness of his/her answers before a duly commissioned Notary Public or a public officer authorized by law to take oaths or sworn statements, e.g. legal officer of the DepEd. Afterwards, we request that the "sworn statement" be mailed/ sent directly to the SAT and addressed to Ms. Honey Pretzel Tolentino, 3rd Floor, Fraud Audit Office, Commission on Audit, Commonwealth Avenue, Quezon City 0880.

Furthermore, the undersigned humbly requests that the SAT be furnished a list of the school principals and their respective schools in that region for the academic years 2014-2015 and 2015-2016, and their current school assignment.
