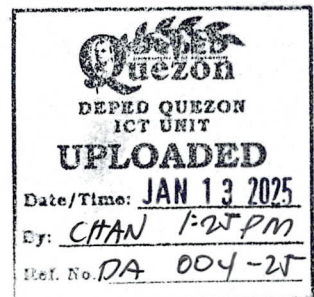

We are pleased to invite you to submit an **ABSTRACT** for **ORAL** or **POSTER PRESENTATION** for consideration at the **Global Multidisciplinary Conference on Artificial Intelligence**.

Theme: *“Research and Leadership in the Digital Era: Harnessing the Power of AI to Transform Education,”*

Deadline of Submission: **April 15, 2025 – LAST AND FINAL CALL**

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

We encourage submissions from both novice and experienced researchers across various disciplines. Please submit your abstract for oral or poster presentation using the following format:

1. Abstracts must be submitted via email to icepdthailand17@gmail.com
2. Indicate your preference for an Oral or Poster Presentation
3. Title of the abstract must be in bold CAPITAL LETTERS, with no abbreviations (max 125 characters including spaces).
4. Title must be followed by name/s of author/s.
5. Provide the affiliation(s) for each author (department, organization, and location, including postal codes).
6. If there are two or more authors, please indicate who among the authors will be presenting by HIGHLIGHTING the name(s). Provide the email address for the presenting author(s).
7. Abstract must be single spaced, Arial Font Style, size 12, with a maximum of 350 words.
8. Full paper must be formatted using the following format: TITLE, Author/s, Affiliation(s), Presenter(s) Email, Introduction, Rationale/Objectives, Methods, Results, Conclusions (bold these subtitles).

Clearly indicate who among the author(s) will be attending the conference and provide full contact information for each in the body of the email when submitting your abstract(s).

SELECTION PROCESS



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Abstracts will be reviewed according to (1) Originality, (2) Relevance, (3) Completeness of the abstract, (4) Impact of Research findings, (5) Clarity in the presentation.

Submissions will be reviewed by the Research Conference Committee.

Please note that not all submissions for oral presentations will be selected. The final decisions will rest with the Research Conference Committee. Researchers will receive a letter of acceptance informing them if they are selected to present either their poster or oral presentation.

Researchers will be notified by email regarding the status of their abstract two weeks after receipt of abstract.

PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

I. ORAL PRESENTATIONS:

1. Please provide a bio-sketch of ≤ 100 words.
2. Researchers will be required to bring their own laptop at the Conference.
3. Time allotted for oral presentations will be 15 minutes (10 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for discussion).

II. POSTER PRESENTATIONS:

1. Researchers are responsible for their poster display, including production, setup, and takedown
2. Posters may not be larger than 4 feet x 6 feet
3. Setup will be between 7:30am and 8:00am and take down will be between 3:30pm and 4:00pm
4. A member of the research team must be present during poster sessions
5. Poster board dimensions will be provided upon confirmation of Committee approval
6. You will be expected to present a 60 second overview of your poster to the conference audience at the lunch break. Creativity is encouraged to entice attendees to view your Poster
