The goal of the conference is a Position Paper on the challenges of Filipino family and youth and possible program responses to them over time, for submission to the Executive and Legislative Department of Government; Local Government Units; Department of Education (Regional and Schools Division Offices); Family Organizations and Interest Groups; and Private and State Universities and Colleges. An abridged version of the Position Paper shall be a major handout during the IFFD (International Foundation for Family Development) Conference in Cebu City in February 2024.

We are sending the program for your information. The intervenors will be identified in a subsequent communication.

We hope you will find this request worth your while considering. The presence students of different social sectors targeted and the highly interactive methodology of the conference promise to yield a good guarantee that the family challenges of a wider array of social groups could be addressed slowly but surely, with much thought and will towards effectiveness, workability, and sustainability.


