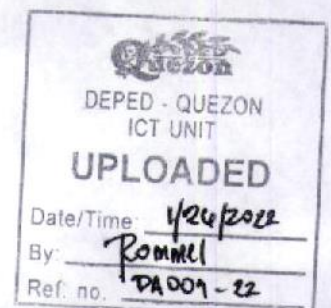

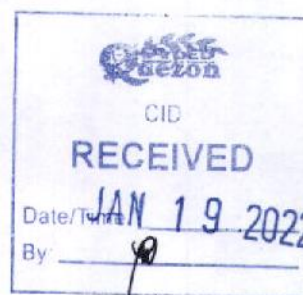
DOST-SEI gives this extension in consideration to the applicants devastated by Typhoon Odette and those who have yet to complete their applications.
