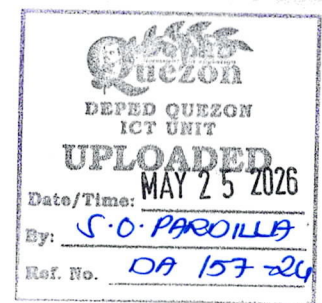

## NATION BUILDERS LEADERSHIP SUMMIT 2026 TRAINING DESIGN

### Course Description

The Nation Builders Leadership Summit 2026 is an intensive training program crafted to strengthen the capabilities of emerging youth leaders from Barangay Councils, SK, LYDO, LYDC, SSG, and allied sectors. With the theme *"Legacy in Action: Empowering Today, Transforming Tomorrow,"* the summit focuses on practical steps to elevate leadership skills, innovate community solutions, and build enduring legacies—preparing participants for leadership transitions like upcoming barangay elections. Participants will engage in hands-on experiences promoting servant leadership, ethical decision-making, and collaborative action. Guided by timeless values—love for God and country, integrity, and excellence—the course offers a nurturing space for leaders to empower their communities today and transform tomorrow.

### Objectives

At the end of the summit, participants shall be able to develop a values-based leadership approach to actionable legacy-building toward effective nation-building. Specifically, participants are expected to:

- a) Define the principles of empowered servant leadership, innovation, and community accountability in a changing landscape.
- b) Assess personal and collective leadership capacity to navigate transitions and create sustainable impact through the lens of ethical governance.
- c) Translate convictions into practical strategies for collaboration, innovation, and legacy that drive community transformation.

### Content

This training is structured to guide participants through a transformative journey, beginning with foundational principles and culminating in actionable strategies for nation-building. The sessions are designed to build upon each other, ensuring a comprehensive and impactful learning experience.

#### **Keynote Message: "Legacy in Action: Empowering Today, Transforming Tomorrow"**

Explore how youth leaders can activate their potential to innovate, collaborate, and build legacies that outlast their tenure

#### **Empowered and Honorable Servant Leaders: Integrity in Everyday Decisions**

Examine pillars of integrity and accountability, with real-life examples for good governance and trust-building.

#### **Surfacing Transition Realities: Interactive Insights**

Participants share and process real transition experiences from leadership roles, surfacing common challenges and opportunities.

#### **Leadership Transitions: Challenges and Opportunities (panel)**

An exploration of election cycles, role shifts, and practical strategies for seamless continuity in community leadership.

#### **Community Accountability in a Changing Landscape**

A discussion on accountability—applying social contract principles in a two-way approach between leaders and communities. Explore how community leaders can foster mutual responsibility, transparent governance, and responsive service amid elections and shifting dynamics.

#### **Crafting My Accountability Pledge: A Personal Commitment**

Translating insights on social contract principles to personal accountability statements.

#### **Sustainable Impact through Collective Leadership and Innovation**

Explore how community leaders blend strengths for innovative, sustainable solutions. Foster community ownership that lasts beyond elections/appointments.

#### **From Personal to Collective Commitment: Crafting Our Legacy SOP**

Participants weave individual accountability statements into a unified collective commitment, then identify practical SOPs that operationalize shared convictions. Through group synthesis and consensus-building, create firm, actionable standards for sustainable leadership—ensuring personal commitments drive community-wide transformation.
