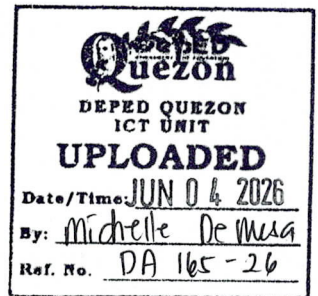

CHAMPLI-STAR AND INTERNATIONAL ACADEMIC OLYMPIADS AND TRAINING PROGRAM 2026

The Champions League for Innovation and Learning Inc. (CHAMPLI), in collaboration with International Olympiad Organization, invites learners from Kindergarten to Grade 12 in public and private schools to participate in the CHAMPLI-Students Training for Advanced Readiness (STAR) and International Academic Olympiads and Training Programs, to be conducted through blended platform.

Participation of learners and teachers from both public and private schools is strictly voluntary and must not interfere with instructional time in compliance with the provision of DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2026, titled "Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education and Activities" as well as DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005, titled "Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith." Furthermore, any off-campus activities must adhere to the guidelines specified in DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017.

This is also subject to the no-collection policy as stated in Section 3 of RA 5546 also known as Act Prohibiting the Sale of Tickets and/or the collection of Contributions for Whatever Project or Purpose from Students and Teachers of Public and Private Schools, Colleges and Universities (Ganzon Law), and reiterated in DepEd Memorandum No.041, s. 2024.
