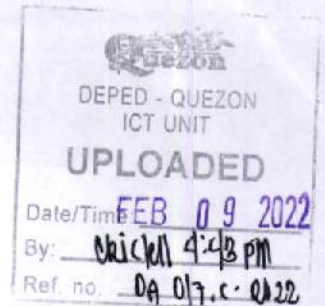



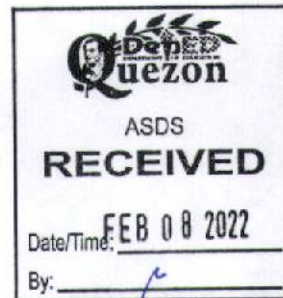
Target participants to the said activity are high school learners. Interested participants are reminded of the following conditions:

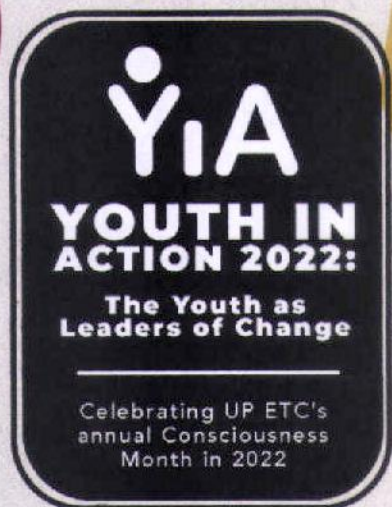
