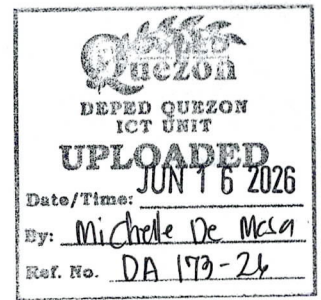

This workshop will be held on the proposed dates listed below.

All institutions—both from the government and private sectors—processing personal data in the Philippines are required to comply with **Republic Act No. 10173**, or the **Data Privacy Act of 2012**, including its **Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR)** and relevant **memorandum circulars** issued by the **National Privacy Commission (NPC)**.

As stated in Section 22 of the Data Privacy Act, each government agency or instrumentality is not only responsible for ensuring compliance with security requirements, but also for safeguarding all sensitive personal information maintained by the agency. This must be done, as far as practicable, using the most appropriate standards recognized by the information and communications technology (ICT) industry, and as recommended by the NPC.

In addition, under **NPC Circular No. 16-01**, one of the general obligations of a government agency engaged in the processing of personal data is to conduct **mandatory, agency-wide training on privacy and data protection policies at least once a year**. Similar training must also be provided to personnel during onboarding.

This workshop aims to provide participants with a **comprehensive understanding of legal and operational compliance** with the Data Privacy Act. It will also enable participants to **effectively manage complaints and respond to data breach incidents** by the NPC guidelines.

Our registration/workshop fee is aligned with the allowable budget under National Budget Circular No. 596 dated January 20, 2025. Please see the attached guidelines issued by the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) for reference.
