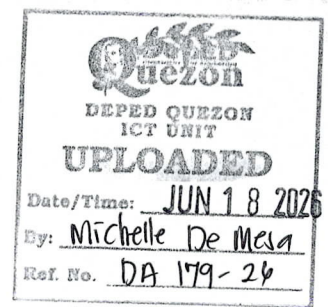

#### PHILIPPINE RED CROSS SAFE CARD MEMBERSHIP PROGRAM

The Philippine Red Cross (PRC) announces the availability of its Membership Accident Assistance Benefits (MAAB) through its Safe Card Membership Program. This initiative helps support the PRC's vital humanitarian services nationwide, including rescue, relief, health, welfare, safety, and recovery interventions.

Pursuant to Republic Act No. 10072 (PRC Act of 2009), Section 6, membership in the PRC is open to all individuals in the Philippines, regardless of citizenship. A contribution to the PRC Annual Fund Campaign grants a one-year membership and is fully deductible for tax purposes.

The MAAB program invites personnel from the Department of Education and its attached agencies to join the PRC roster. As Safe Card holders, members become part of the PRC's national framework of volunteers, help sustain its humanitarian operations nationwide, and are entitled to the following benefits:

1. One unit of blood for emergency transfusion;
2. One emergency ambulance transport service, where available; and
3. Accident insurance coverage underwritten by Prudential Guarantee.
