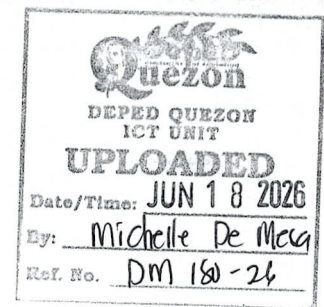

The International Brilliant Minds Olympiad (IBMO) Philippines invites learners in Grades 4 through senior high school to participate in the World Brilliant Student Challenge (WBSC) on June 21 (Preliminary Round) and July 2–3, 2026 (Grand Finals).

The WBSC is an online competition that offers a platform for learners to showcase their knowledge and skills in Mathematics, Science, English, Geography, Economics, and Physics. The competition levels are as follows:

Participation Levels	Subject Categories
Level 1: Grades 4–6 (Primary school learners)	Mathematics, Science, and English
Level 2: Grades 7–10 (Secondary school learners)	
Level 3: Grades 11–12 (High school learners)	Mathematics, Biology, English, Physics, Geography, and Economics
