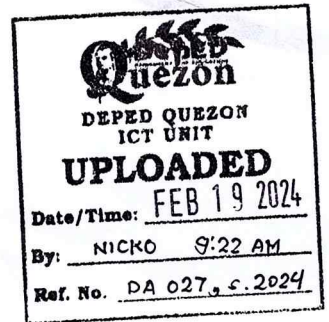

This activity is part of the DOST Region IV – A project entitled Community Empowerment through Science and Technology. The activity primarily aims to heighten the interest and awareness of the students in marine conservation and marine coastal protection, complementing the activities are topics on Space and Astronomy.

The participants in this activity are student representatives from the four (4) junior high schools in Quezon District. The student representatives are required to secure parents' consent for the said activity. On the other hand, teacher's participation is voluntary and will follow provisions on teachers' participation on extra-curricular activities.

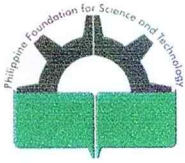

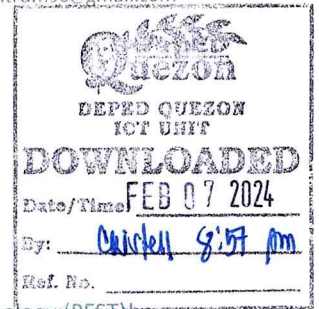
In our commitment to facilitating this activity, transportation services for the students to and from their respective schools to the event venue, meals, activity kits and certificates of participation.
