

# WHAT IS AGRIKONOMIYA?



AgriKonomiya 2022 is one of the UP Agricultural and Applied Economics Circle's flagship projects for the year 2022 which tackles the current state of the agricultural sector in the country. This event is anchored to the

objective of the organization to promote Agricultural and Applied Economics as a field of study and a career. With the success of last year's AgriKonomiya 2021 having over 80 participating schools nationwide and a feature article with Rappler, AgriKonomiya 2022 will still be a month-long event with four (4) competitions and one (1) webinar.

With its theme "To Infinity and Beyond: Securing the Future through Sustainable Agriculture", Junior and Senior High School students from different schools all over the Philippines will compete with each other in a poster making competition, essay writing competition, spoken word poetry competition, and lastly, an agricultural resolution pitch competition. For this year's competitions, schools can send a maximum of three students for the poster making competition,

a maximum of two students for the essay writing competition, at least one student for the spoken word poetry competition, and one team of three members for agricultural resolution pitch competition.

AgriKonomiya 2022 officially starts on March 1, which is also the start of submission of entries for the competitions. The webinar will mark the culmination of the event. It will be held on March 26 via Zoom, which will be followed by the awarding ceremony.

Agrikonomiya, the organization hopes a significant increase in the awareness of the students and those reached by the event regarding the Philippine agriculture, and



ponder on important issues related to our farmers and in the agricultural value chain. More importantly, the organization aspires to encourage its participants to take an active role in the agricultural sector and recognize that Agricultural and Applied Economics is an excellent field of study to fulfill this aspiration.

# Agricultural Resolutions Pitch Competition

The Agricultural Resolutions Pitch Competition or Agri-Pitch Competition is a team event wherein the participants are required to formulate innovative resolutions to the topic given by the organizers. This event is a two-part event wherein the first part requires the team to submit a written report of their proposed solutions and the top scorers from the first part would proceed to the final round wherein they would pitch live in front of the judges.

#### **COMPETITION GUIDELINES**

- Each school can only send one (1) team composed of three (3) members for this competition. The first 20 teams to register in the competition are the official participants.
- Each team will be required to articulate an innovative and realistic resolution to a current agricultural issue that will be set by the organizers. The issue will be released on March 1, 2022, Tuesday.
- The teams' resolution shall be conveyed on a written report. The paper shall consist of the following parts: Title, Introduction, Statement of the Problem, Resolution, Conclusion, and References. It must also be written in English only.
- The template for the paper will be given on the date the topic is released. The paper should not exceed fifteen (15) pages, with the exception of the title page and references.
- The accomplished paper, in PDF format, must be submitted on or before March 10, 2022, Thursday via Google Form sent on March 1. This will allow the judges to thoroughly review and familiarize themselves with the papers ahead of time.

# Agricultural Resolutions Pitch Competition

- The 8 teams with the highest score based on the criteria will be announced on March 15, 2022, Tuesday. The finalists are required to prepare a video presentation, in no more than seven (7) minutes, discussing the contents of their paper.
- The accomplished video, in MP4/MOV format, must be submitted on or before March 18, 2022, Friday via Google Drive sent on March 15. This will allow the event organizers to ensure they are not damaged or corrupted.
- The video will be presented to the judges via Zoom on March 19, 2022, Saturday. All members of the teams must be present and they should wear their school uniform or any presentable attire. After every presentation, ten (10) minutes will be allotted for the Question and Answer portion between the presenting team and the board of judges.
- Plagiarism is strictly prohibited. Organizers will check the submitted papers and will return if it exceeds 14% similarity index.
- The winning teams will be announced on March 26, 2022, Saturday during the culminating event.

### **Essay Writing Competition**

The Agrikonomiya 2022 Essay Writing competition main objective is to promote and encourage students' leadership skills and creativity through essay writing. The competition brings out the writer's ability to think and write logically about issues relating to agriculture and economy; and how they see the future of Philippine agriculture based on the current trend. Participants are expected to write persuasively and present their ideas in a well-connected and meaningful manner, guided by the principles of different agricultural economic concepts and theories. The main topic of this competition will revolve to this year's Agrikonomiya's overall theme "To Infinity and Beyond: Securing the Future through Sustainable Agriculture".

#### **COMPETITION GUIDELINES**

- At most two (2) participants for each category (English and Filipino) from participating schools can join the essay writing competition.
- All participants from each participating school will be given twelve (12) days—from March 1 to March 12 —to write and submit their write-ups about the given topic.
- The essay must be written in either uniformly English or Filipino language only. Code-switching is not allowed.
- The essay shall not exceed 1,500 words and must be in the following format:
  - Font: Palatino
  - Font size: 11
  - o Margins: 1"
  - o Size: A4
  - Spacing: 1.15

### **Essay Writing Competition**

- The entries will be submitted as PDF through Google Forms that will be sent to your email after registration.
- The file name of the essay shall be in the following format: NAMEOFSCHOOL\_SURNAME\_FIRSTNAME (e.g., UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES-LOSBANOS\_DELACRUZ\_JUAN)
- Plagiarism is strictly prohibited. Once submitted, the paper's similarity index will be checked by the organizers. If the similarity index exceeds 14%, the paper will be returned to the respective participant for revision.
- The winners will be announced on March 26.

#### **OVERALL CHAMPION & RUNNER-UPS**

Among the schools who joined the competition, there will be one (1) Overall Champion, one (1) Overall 1st Runner-up, and one (1) Overall 2nd Runner-up. The schools will receive a trophy and certificate for standing out among the schools who joined Agrikonomiya 2022.

# Spoken Word Poetry Competition

Agrikonomiya 2022 Spoken Word Poetry Competition aims to encourage the youth, specifically the students from Junior High School and Senior High School to showcase their skills in creative writing, together with their ability for poetic presentation. Students' compositions are anticipated to be characterised by rhyme, repetitions, improvisation, and word play, as well as spoken word poems that address issues related to the agricultural sector in the Philippines.

### COMPETITION GUIDELINES

- Each school can send one (1) or more participants for the competition. Participants are given a week to compose their own poem in line with the topic given.
- The topic will be sent on March 1, and the poem must be submitted on or before March 6.
- The participant is required to submit a maximum of a 3-minute video performance of the poem that she/he did on March 12.
- The poem may be written and spoken in English or Filipino only.
   Code-switching is prohibited both in the write-up and video performance.
- Both the poem and video performance must be submitted via Google Drive which will be provided together with the topic reveal.
- The poem must be submitted in as a PDF file and should follow the following format:
  - Font Style: Times New Roman
  - o Font Size: 12
  - Margins: 1" all sides
  - Paper Size: A4
  - Line Spacing: 1.15

# **Spoken Word Poetry Competition**

- The file name for the poem should follow the format: NameOfSchool\_SurnameGivenName\_Poem.pdf (e.g.,UPLB\_LopezDianaMae\_Poem.pdf)
- The video performance must be a one-take video. Editing the video itself is not allowed. The participant must wear smart casual attire. Video performances must be in MP4 or MOV format
- The file name for the video performance should follow the format:
  - NameOfSchool\_SurnameGivenName\_VideoPerformance.mp4/mov (e.g., UPLB\_LopezDianaMae\_VideoPerfomance.mp4/mov)
- Plagiarism is strictly prohibited. The organizers will check the similarity index of the poem after submission. If the similarity index exceeds 14%, the participant will be disqualified.

### Poster Making Competition

The Poster Making competition aims to raise awareness, regarding issues in the agricultural sector and how sustainable agriculture can be a solution, through the use of art. In line with the theme of AgriKonomiya 2022 "To Infinity and Beyond: Securing the Future through Sustainable Agriculture", this competition allows Junior High School and Senior High School students to express their interpretation of the theme through creative and innovative ways.

#### **COMPETITION GUIDELINES**

- Every participating school can send 1 to 3 participants for the competition.
- Each participant should submit ONE entry only.
- The poster should illustrate, interpret, and emphasize the theme of AGRIKONOMIYA 2022: To Infinity and Beyond: Securing the Future through Sustainable Agriculture.
- Any medium can be used upon making the poster and each poster must have its own name or title.
- Submission of entries will start on March 1, 2022 and not later than March 12, 2022.
- The poster shall be submitted in JPEG/PNG format through the Google Form provided by the organizers.
- The file name of the poster shall follow the format: NAMEOFSCHOOL\_SURNAME\_FIRSTNAME\_POSTER TITLE (e.g., UPLB\_DELACRUZ\_JUAN\_AGRICULTURE)
- The artist will be held accountable for any issues that may arise with regards to the originality and authenticity of the design.

## Poster Making Competition

- Part of the criteria is the accumulation of likes or heart reactions on Facebook. All participating entries will be posted on the AGRIKONOMIYA 2022 page starting March 14, 2022 and will end on March 21, 2022.

  - Spoken Word Poetry Competition: one (1) or more participants
  - Poster Making Competition: minimum of one (1) and a maximum of three (3) participants
  - Essay Writing Competition
    - English: minimum of one (1) and a maximum of two (2) participants
    - Filipino: minimum of one (1) and a maximum of two (2) participants
  - Agricultural Resolutions Pitch: one (1) team composed of three (3) members 4. The FIRST 20 teams to register in the competition are the ONLY official participants in Agricultural Resolutions Pitch.
