Dear Dr. Alicaya,

Last 2 February 2021, the Philippine Business for Education (PBEd) launched the First Future 2.0 project which provides free online training programs aimed at creating workplace opportunities for our youth in the contact center industry.

Unemployment remains one of the major concerns in the world. In October 2020, more than 1.3 million youth were unemployed. With the COVID-19 pandemic, this number has significantly increased. Even though employers are now becoming more receptive to hiring non-degree holders, young people without college degrees are still at a disadvantage because most companies still put more weight on credentials rather than competencies.

First Future 2.0 aims to help address this by increasing the potential of non-degree holders. Implemented by the Philippine Business for Education (PBEd) and funded by Citi Foundation, First Future 2.0 helps youths aged 18-30 to get into the workplace and move up the career ladder by developing skilling, re-skilling, and upskilling training programs that are industry-vetted, recognized, and accessible through various modes of delivery.

YGOAL Inc. is PBEd's implementing partner for First Future 2.0's Youth Engagement Project which aims to get our youth to enroll in the training programs. YGOAL would, therefore, like to partner with you to see how First Future-2.0 can help our sentor high school graduates, particularly those who are not able to proceed to college, to enroll in the training program Future-Ready CSR which is designed to develop a growth mindset for a Customer Service Representative. Graduates of the course are provided Certificates of Completion which they can add to their skills set and resume. In addition, PBEd will provide a Skills to Succeed online training which is an interactive career guidance and work-readiness course designed to help participants be work-ready and teach them on how they can prepare for their job search and ultimately, the workplace.
