The Philippine Historical Association is a professional association of historians and history teachers in the Philippines. It was founded on September 18, 1955 by a group of prominent historians at Carbungco Restaurant located at Lepanto St., Manila. Among the group were Encarnacion Alzona, Gabriel Fabella, Gregorio Zaide, Nicolas Zafra, Celedonio Resurreccion, Teodoro Agoncillo and Esteban de Ocampo.

PHA's main objective is to promote and propagate historical knowledge and studies. It promotes historical research and scholarship among its members through the publication of their works. The Association has an official journal, called "Historical Bulletin" which is published every year.

The main annual activity of the Association is the holding of an annual conference whose theme deals with timely and relevant issues of national concern. To promote the study and appreciation of history, the Association initiates, sponsors and supports the holding of seminars on the teaching of history in Manila and in different parts of the country.

PHA is affiliated with the National Historical Commission of the Philippines - Local Historical Committees Network, National Commission for Culture and the Arts - National Committee on Historical Research and the Philippine Social Science Council.

PHA designs programs and activities that help create opportunities for the professional growth of its members through seminars, conferences and publications.
