Musikalinangan at Musika de Mayo sa Pasig




REGISTRATION

- 1. Only twelve (12) choirs will be admitted for *Musikalinangan* on a "first come, first served" basis. The top eight (8) choirs in the preliminaries will advance to *Musika de Mayo*. Individual singers or conductors are welcome to join the workshops.
- 2. All choirs must have a minimum of 15 participants to a maximum of 30 participants, including the conductor and/or instrumentalist.
 - a. Additional participants may join *Musikalinangan* workshops but must pay an additional fee of PHP 1,000.00 per succeeding participant.
 - b. However, for the competition rounds: preliminary and final, each choir is strictly to have a minimum of 15 singers and a maximum of 30 singers, excluding the conductor and/or instrumentalist.
- 3. Registration Fees:
 - a. Choirs: **PHP 15,000.00** (15-30 members)
 - i. <u>Inclusive of</u> the choir members workshop, conductor workshop, workshop kits, one-hour customized workshop, one-on-one advisory and consultation, and individual passes for the Fellowship Lunch.
 - b. Individual Participant (Conductors or Singers who do not belong to any participating choir): PHP 2,000.00
 - i. <u>Inclusive of participation in the full-day workshop</u>, workshop kit, a pass for the Fellowship Lunch, and the elimination competition round.










- c. Complimentary tickets for Musika de Mayo shall be given as well.
 - i. Five (5) tickets each for the choir finalists.
 - ii. Two (2) tickets each for the eliminated choirs.
 - iii. One (1) ticket each for the individual participants
- 4. Early Bird Registration and Payments:
 - a. Regular registrations begin on January 9, 2024, until February 29, 2024.
 - b. All registration payments will be directed to the GCash and/or BPI accounts of the Project Head, Josh Malabanan.
 - i. Please use the QR code below for registration and payments.



- 5. Cancellation and Refund Policy:
 - a. Within Seven (7) Days Upon Registration:
 - i. Choirs and individual participants who cancel their registration within seven (7) days of registration are eligible for a 100% refund.
 - b. Within Thirty (30) Days Before March 6, 2024:
 - i. Choirs and individual participants who cancel their registration within thirty (30) days can receive a 100% refund if they find a replacement.
 - ii. If no replacement is found, a 75% refund will be issued.
 - c. After Thirty (30) Days Before March 6, 2024:
 - i. Cancellations made between 31-60 days after registration and before March 6, 2024, are eligible for a 50% refund.











- d. On or After March 6, 2024:
 - i. Cancellations made on or after March 6, 2024, are **not** eligible for refunds.
 - ii. This rule (d) overrides the preceding rules.
- e. Please note that all refund requests must be submitted in writing to our Project Head, Josh Malabanan, via email at joshuayran.malabanan@uap.asia.
- f. Refunds will be processed within seven (7) business days upon <u>approval</u> of the request. The approval of the request is considered on the day Josh Malabanan responds to the email inquiry.
- g. MAGNIFICAT 2024 reserves the right to modify this policy at its discretion.





 - a. Best Conductor Certificate
 - b. Most Improved Choir Certificate (Chosen by the organizers of Musikalinangan)









RULES AND GUIDELINES

1. Music and Duration: Each choir must sing the following:


Musikalinangan

- a. For the festival: Total duration must not exceed one (1) minute.
 - i. An excerpt of any upbeat song that highlights the choir's strength.
- b. For the customized workshop
 - i. Any of the choir's competition pieces
- c. For the Preliminary Competition: Total duration of performance (first note to last note) must not exceed ten (10) minutes.
 - i. One (1) Marian composition/arrangement of any language
 - ii. One (1) choral composition/arrangement of any genre and language


Musika de Mayo

- a. Total duration of performance (first note to last note) shall not exceed ten (10) minutes.
 - i. One (1) Marian composition/arrangement sung during the eliminations
 - ii. One (1) choral composition/arrangement with the theme "Umaagos ang Pag-asa," in line with Pasig City's motto.
- 2. **Voicing:** All compositions/arrangements must be sung in acapella (non-pitched instruments are allowed) and in a minimum of 4-part harmony.
- 3. Criteria for Evaluation: The scoring criteria will have a maximum of 100 points.
 - a. TECHNICALITY (60 pts)
 - Precision of Pitch, Blending, Vocal Quality, Fidelity to the Score
 - b. ARTISTRY (30 pts)
 - Music Interpretation, Dynamics, Expression, Appearance, Stage Deportment
 - c. DIFFICULTY OF SCORE (10 pts)
- 4. **Penalties:** There will be penalties for exceeding the allotted performance time.
 - a. Excess of 10-15 seconds: 1-point penalty









b. Excess of 16-30 seconds: 2-point penalty

c. Excess of 31-59 seconds: 3-point penalty

d. Excess of 1 minute or more: 5-point penalty

5. **Judges:** The jury will consist of internationally awarded choral conductors. Judges' decisions will be deemed final and irrevocable.

6. Submission of Scores

- a. All copyrights of the competition scores are the responsibility of the choirs themselves.
- b. Choirs must submit three (3) <u>original</u> copies of the competition scores together with a copy of the receipt if purchased, **or** three (3) <u>clearly</u> printed copies of the scores <u>together with</u> a letter of authorization from the composer/arranger allowing the choir the use of the score, <u>on or before</u> March 6, 2024.
- c. The organizing body must approve the scores and reserves the right to ask to change competition pieces if necessary.
