

Rationale:

Student development in the new normal is a primary concern of the United Private Educational Institutions of Quezon Province (UPEIQ). This is done through ensuring that every student is given an equal opportunity and access to training programs that will enhance their competencies.

Considering three important aspects of student development such as honing leadership, and entrepreneurial skills, and research competency, the UPEIQ will stage the 2023 Senior High School Students' Summit and Awards Ceremonies, Year 2. The first part of the Summit will be devoted to the presentation of the invited plenary speaker; and the second part shall be focused on the presentation of the participants in the different categories, and will be capped-off by the awarding ceremonies.

Last year's summit focused on the government's effort to renew and develop entrepreneurship which begins in the basic education level, two of the topics that were covered in the summit were entrepreneurship and technopreneurship. These topics gave the students additional information on how to develop, enhance and apply their entrepreneurial and technopreneurial skills.

This 2023, in support with the Department of Education (DepEd's) policy development process, research agenda, and policy and program development and implementation, the department continues to promote and strengthen the culture of research in basic education. Hence, the main topic of this year's summit will center on how the interplay among research, entrepreneurship, and leadership will help in developing competent students whose impact can be measured by being productive members of the society today and beyond.

In the second part of this year's summit, selected participants will vie for the following awards:

- 1. Youth Achiever Award in the Field of Research
- 2. Youth Achiever Award in the Field of Entrepreneurship
- 3. Youth Achiever Award in the Field of Inspirational Leadership

Objectives:

Considering the value of student development and the importance of topics being highlighted above, the following are the specific objectives of this conference and award ceremonies:



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- Define the leadership values represented by the research that are carried on for entrepreneurship.
- 2. Discuss the role of research in entrepreneurship.
- Reflect on the role of research in pushing the frontiers of knowledge and developing cutting-edge technologies that can be converted to something with economic value.
- 4. Describe the roles of research in the nation-building.
- 5. Share best practices in enhancing research competencies and honing research skills.
- Recognize achievements of Senior High School students in the areas of research, entrepreneurship, and inspirational leadership.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the award, you must:

Selection Process

- ✓ One letter of recommendation from an adult who can speak to your character, and entrepreneurial prowess and potential. This adult must be unrelated to you and must also be one of the following: teacher, counselor or school administrator; advisor; coach; employer; or community leader.
- ✓ Portfolio/documentation of their entrepreneurial journey
- ✓ Applicants are required to submit a brief self-introduction video containing the following details:
 - A. name of the applicant,

 - D. one to two-sentence description of his/her entrepreneurial project.

The 2023 Youth Achiever Award in the Field of Research honor and recognize exemplary young leaders who have manifested research skills and competencies by undertaking a qualitative or quantitative research, capstone project. The research or capstone project should have been presented before a panel of experts and was subsequently approved. These research or capstone projects should have an impact in the school and external communities.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the award, you must:

- ✓ Be a bona fide student of the school being represented.
- ✓ Demonstrate outstanding achievement in the field of research.
- ✓ Exhibit the ability to set and achieve goals

Selection Process

Selection is based on demonstration of research skills through a research or capstone project. Names of the short-listed applicants will be announced on the date of the summit May 11, 2023.

Winning applicants will be recognized at the "2023 UPEIQ Senior High School Students' Summit and Youth Achievers Award" to be held on May 11, 2023 at MSEUF-Catanauan, Quezon.

- ✓ Applicants are required to submit a brief self-introduction video containing the following details:
 - A. name of the applicant,
 - B. grade level, school,
 - C. title
 - D. one to two-sentence description of his/her entrepreneurial project.

The applicant must be in his/her school uniform in the video presentation.

Impact of Being a Researcher to the School, Curriculum and to the Community -20%

For the final judging, applicants should wear corporate/business attire during the presentation.

The short listed applicants shall present within 5 to 7 minutes using power point containing the following information:

- > Title
- > Short Introduction
- > Statement of the Problem with hypothesis when necessary
- ➤ Methodology Used
- > Tables and Graphs related to the findings
- > Interpretation of the Data
- Results and Conclusion
