



# What is YSA?

- Covers new and innovative projects/models developed by senior high school students under the STEM strand;
- Venue to recognize high efforts of senior high school students under the STEM strand, and to motivate them to engage in S&T award winning innovations; and
- New and innovative projects/models should possess features and characteristics that are not contrary to public order, morals, publics and welfare.

# Guidelines

Open to all senior
high school
students under the
STEM strand in both
private and public
schools in
CALABARZON

Researches may either be basic or applied and conducted mainly in the Philippines. Researches should have been completed within a period of three years preceding the award (2020-2022).

## Requirements


- Six (6) hardcopies of entries including abstract
- 5-minute video presentation
- · Endorsement from school head
- Student's profile
- Copies of certificates of previous awards (if any)
- Proof of enrolment during the conduct of research
- Certificate of good standing
- Certificate of originality
- All entries must be addressed to the Chair, LBSCFI R&D Awards Committee and concurrent Officerin-Charge, Office of the Executive Director for R&D of DOST-PCAARRD, and received not later than June 30, 2023.
- The Board of Judges has the right not to declare any winner.
- Decision of the Board of Judges shall be final.

## Prizes

Winners will receive plaques of recognition and cash prize as follows:

- First place: PhP30,000.00
- Second place: PhP20,000.00
- Third place: PhP15,000.00
- Two (2) Consolation prizes: PhP2,000.00 each






