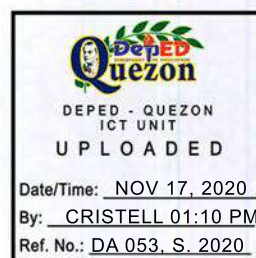

21st KANAGAWA BIENNIAL WORLD CHILDREN'S ART EXHIBITION

The Kanagawa Prefectural Government invites Filipino children to submit entries to the 21st Kanagawa Biennial World Children's Art Exhibition until **November 30, 2020.**

The exhibition aims to use the power of painting to foster the dreams and creativity of young children who will become the leaders of tomorrow and to promote further understanding of the world's diverse cultures and lifestyles in the world.

Entries must meet the following requirements:

1. Made by children born between September 2, 2004 to September 1, 2016;
2. Only one entry per participant;
3. Unreleased original and sole work-collaboration and series painting shall not be accepted;
4. In quarto (within 380 x 540 mm) or canvas less than F8 (460 x 380 mm) size;
5. Not framed or matted;
6. Made with any material, medium, or method except modeled or digital work;
7. Are not uneven and fragile/breakable; and
8. Does not contain products that may rot or attract insects, e.g., food.

All entries must be sent via courier. Interested participants may access other contest details through <https://www.earthplaza.jp/biennial/English/index.html>.

Prize winners will be notified by post or email by mid-March 2021. The list of winners will also be posted on the Kanagawa Biennial website. Exhibition will be from July 6 to August 22, 2020 at the Gallery of Kanagawa Plaza for Global Citizenship and September 2021 to March 2022 at cultural facilities in the Kanagawa Prefecture. Invitation of foreign winners to exhibitions are not planned.

Participation of public and private schools shall be subject to the no-disruption-of classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.
