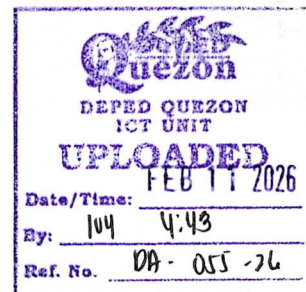

The Singapore Ministry of Education is still accepting applications for the ASEAN Scholarship for the 2027 academic year, which will offer pre-tertiary study support for learners from the Philippines.

The scholarship is open to all Filipino learners and will cover four years of study support, from junior high school through senior high school, including an annual allowance, return economy airfare, school fees, hostel accommodation, and a settling-in allowance.

The eligibility criteria for Filipino students are as follows:

- English Proficiency: Must be proficient in the English language.
- Age Requirement: Must be born between January 2, 2010, and January 1, 2013.
- Grade Level: Must currently be enrolled in Grade 8 or higher.
- Academic Standing: Must have a consistent record of high performance in school examinations.
- Extracurricular Record: Must have a strong record of participation in co-curricular activities.

Prospective applicants are invited to submit their applications online at the Singapore Ministry of Education website at <https://go.gov.sg/as-philippines>. The application period is open until February 16, 2026.
