The Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs (PSYSC) will conduct the 2016 National Youth Science, Technology and Environment Summer Camp (NYSTESC) with the theme Retrovive: Amplifying the Echoes of Time from July 22 to 25, 2016 at the D'Leonor Inland Resort and Adventure Park in Cabantian, Buhangin District, Davao City.

#### The Camp aims to:

- 1. spark the interest and awareness of the participants on the physics of sound through lectures and interactive workshops;
- 2. develop their interpersonal skills through interactions with students from different regions and backgrounds; and
