Rationale:

Student development in the midst of the pandemic is a primary concern of the United Private Educational Institutions of Quezon Province (UPEIQ). This is done through ensuring that every student is given an equal opportunity and access to training programs that will enhance their competencies.

Considering three important aspects of student development such as honing entrepreneurial skills, research competency and mental health, the UPEIQ will stage the 2022 Senior High School Students' Summit and Awards Ceremonies. The first part of the Summit will be devoted to the presentation of the invited resource speakers and the second part shall be focusing on the awarding ceremonies.

- ✓ One letter of recommendation from an adult who can speak to your character, and entrepreneurial prowess and potential. This adult must be unrelated to you and must also be one of the following: teacher, counselor or school administrator; advisor; coach; employer; or community leader.

Shortlisting of Applicants

There will be shortlisting of applicants based on the applications submitted. A shortlist of applicants who will advance to final judging will be made using the following criteria.

Completion of the Application Form-10%

Correctness of Response to the Essay Questions-70%

These research or capstone projects should have an impact in the school and external communities.

- ✓ Demonstrate outstanding achievement in the field of research.
- ✓ Exhibit the ability to set and achieve goals

Selection Process

Selection is based on demonstration of research skills through a research or capstone project. Winning applicants will be notified by April 25, 2022.

Selected recipients will be recognized at the "2022 UPEIQ Senior High School Students' Virtual Conference and Youth Achievers Award" to be held via Zoom on April 29 and 30, 2022.
