

The Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization (SEAMEO) and the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, Japan (MEXT), in cooperation with the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) Multisectoral Regional Office in Bangkok, will conduct the 2023 SEAMEO-Japan Education for Sustainable Development (ESD) Award with the theme, Promoting Environmental Education through Utilizing Renewable Energy.

The 2023 SEAMEO-Japan ESD Award aims to:

- 1. increase public awareness and acquire knowledge, skills, values, experiences, and also the determination to solve present and future environmental problems;
