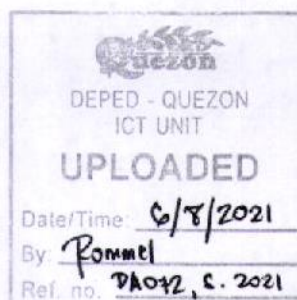
**PHILIPPINE EAGLE WEEK CELEBRATION**

Through the 45-minute documentary, learners will be able to learn the life of a Philippine Eagle and explore the means to protect and save them from extinction.

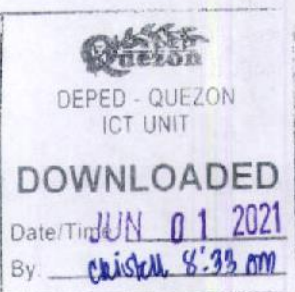
If participation in the above-mentioned activity from your Division is deemed necessary, please be reminded of the following conditions:


