<p><b>Day 1 (April 16, 2026, Thursday)</b></p> <p><b>Key Provisions of RA No. 12009 (NGPA) and its IRR</b> This covers the major reforms introduced by RA 12009 and its implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) on government procurement, including the principles of transparency, competitiveness, efficiency, accountability, sustainability, and value for money. It highlights updates on procurement planning, modes of procurement, digital/PhilGEPS-based procurement, lifecycle costing, contract implementation, and sanctions/penalties, applicable to procurement of goods, infrastructure projects, and consulting services by government entities.</p> <p><b>Strategic Procurement Planning</b> This covers the systematic process of aligning procurement activities with agency objectives through effective planning, including market analysis/engagement, preparation of PPMP and APP, budgeting and scheduling of procurement activities, and identification of the most suitable procurement strategies to ensure efficiency, competitiveness, transparency, sustainability, and value for money.</p>	<p><b>Day 2 (April 17, 2026, Friday)</b></p> <p><b>Modes of Public Procurement</b> This covers the procurement methods provided under RA No. 12009 (NGPA) for acquiring goods, infrastructure projects, and consulting services, including competitive/regular procurement and alternative procurement modes, focusing on the criteria and conditions for their use, procedural requirements, and safeguards to ensure transparency, competitiveness, efficiency &amp; accountability.</p> <p><b>Day 3 (April 18, 2026, Saturday)</b></p> <p><b>Contract Implementation and Sanction Mechanism in NGPA</b> This covers the procedures and responsibilities for executing and managing government contracts under RA 12009 (NGPA), including monitoring performance, ensuring compliance with terms, handling variations or disputes, and enforcing sanctions such as suspension, blacklisting, or penalties for violations by contractors or procurement officials, to uphold accountability, &amp; transparency</p>	<p><b>Day 3 (April 18, 2026, Saturday)</b></p> <p><b>Updated Bid Forms</b> This covers the standardized bid documents and forms prescribed under RA 12009 (NGPA) and its IRR, which must be used by all government procuring entities to ensure uniformity, transparency, clarity, and compliance in the bidding and procurement process.</p> <p><b>GPPB Updates</b> This covers the latest issuances, circulars, guidelines, and resolutions from the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) under RA 12009 (NGPA), which provide clarifications, procedural updates, and policy directions to ensure consistent, transparent and efficient use of government funds.</p>
