





Facts about why Legazpi is completely Safe from the Current Volcanic

Eruptions of Mayon

- The distance between Mayon Volcano and Legazpi, Albay, is 14 km. A clear indicator that Legazpi City is safe and far from the dangers of the current Mayon volcano eruption.
- Flights to and from Legazpi (DRP) are proceeding as of this time, routed appropriately to avoid the general vicinity of Mount Mayon. If the situation develops and affects the safety of airline operations in the Bicol region in any way, airlines will adjust or cancel scheduled flights as necessary.
- Local transportation vehicles are still operating normally. (Buses, vans, jeepneys, etc.)
