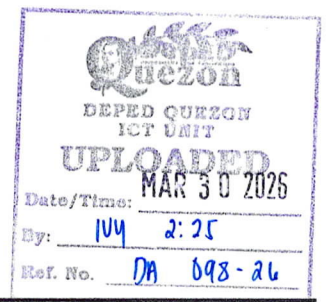

UP UGNAYAN NG PAHINUNGÓD'S 32nd ANNIVERSARY AND EDUCATIONAL
ENHANCEMENT PROGRAMS

Mandated to provide volunteering opportunities for University of the Philippines (UP) faculty, students, staff, and alumni in service of underserved communities, the Ugnayan ng Pahinungód/Oblation Corps System Office, together with all UP Constituent Units—UP Baguio, UP Cebu, UP Diliman, UP Los Baños, UP Manila, UP Mindanao, UP Open University, and UP Visayas—and the autonomous UP Tacloban College, marks its 32nd anniversary by reaffirming its commitment to implementing innovative programs that address the country's education crisis, particularly in geographically isolated and underserved areas.

These programs include:

- Gurong Pahinungód - The UP Gurong Pahinungód (GP) is the flagship initiative of Ugnayan ng Pahinungód, deploying UP graduates to far-flung and underserved public schools. For one school year, GPs serve as teachers, mentors, and ambassadors for UP who help bring the University's services closer to underserved communities.
- Affirmative Action Program - This program supports inclusive education in state universities and colleges by providing enrichment activities in reading, writing, mathematics, and science, as well as preparation for college admission tests.
- Teacher Development Program - This offers online and in-person capacity-building initiatives designed to train, equip, and engage educators through various professional development activities.
- Tutorial Services and Literacy Programs - Implemented with partner institutions and volunteers, these programs help learners build proficiency through interactive activities and meaningful learning experiences.
