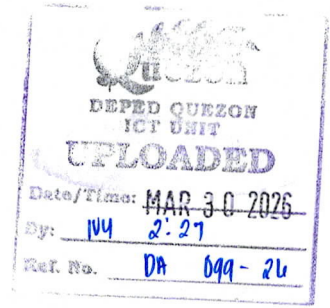

Thrive: Integrating the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) through Learner-Centered and Transformative Pedagogies	September 4–6, 2026 November 6–8, 2026	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Integrate sustainability concepts across the curriculum by applying interdisciplinary content knowledge, citing and explaining the 17 SDGs, and embedding Education for Sustainable Development (ESD) principles in learner-centered, transformative instructional strategies.</li> <li>Use research and policy analysis to guide practice by identifying instructional gaps, examining the state of SDG/ESD implementation in Philippine schools, and making informed pedagogical and programmatic decisions.</li> <li>Design coherent, context-responsive sustainability programs through Whole-School Approach planning, inclusive learning initiatives, and the development of key sustainability competencies such as systems thinking, critical thinking, collaboration, and ethical reasoning.</li> </ul>
