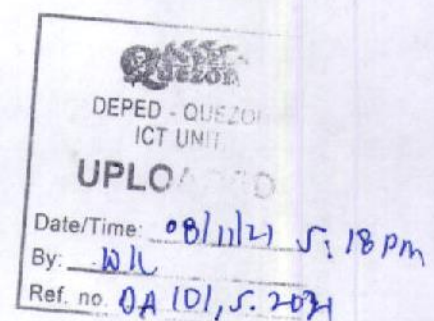

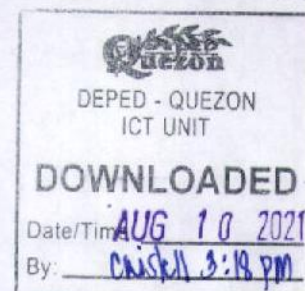
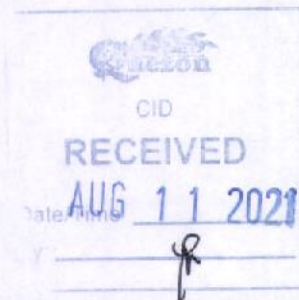
Other public lectures and events that will be conducted to commemorate the 500th anniversary of the Victory at Mactan are attached. Interested participants are reminded of the following:


