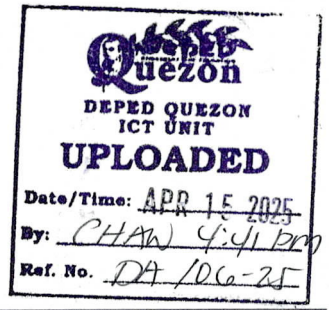

Furthermore, any off-campus activities must adhere to the guidelines specified in DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017.

The camp aims to

1. provide the participants a thorough understanding of the concepts and impact of a selected ST&E topic and its multi-disciplinary fields through interaction with experts in the field;
2. promote interest and awareness in their selected ST&E field and encourage them to acquire further knowledge in such field;
3. encourage them to pursue opportunities in their selected ST&E field, in the future;
4. provide a venue for the exchange of ideas and promote camaraderie among elementary science club members nationwide; and
5. encourage more students to join science clubs and to be involved in the science clubbing movement.

Junior and senior high school learners, teachers, science club advisers, and coaches nationwide are encouraged to participate in this event.

Participation of learners and teachers from public and private schools shall be purely voluntary and will not hamper instructional time in compliance with the provisions of DepEd Order (DO) No. 009, s. 2024, titled Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2024–2025 and DO 9, s. 2005 titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith and the policy on off-campus activities stated in DO 66, s. 2017.
