
In reference to the communication from Council for the Welfare of Children, this advisory is issued for the information of the Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads.

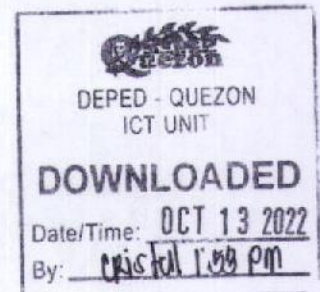

Greetings from the Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC)!

The alarming conditions affecting children in the Philippines when it comes to communication and information technology are false information also known as fake news as well as online sexual abuse and exploitation.

In particular, children fell victims of these abuses with the use of Information Communication Technology (ICT). The number of abuse and its consequent effects magnified by reason of the COVID-19 pandemic, considering the limited face-to-face interactions and the resort to the use of social media platforms. The irresponsible use of ICT also aggravates the number of Online Sexual Abuse or Exploitation of Children (OSAEC) and Child Sexual Abuse or Exploitation Materials (CSAEM).
