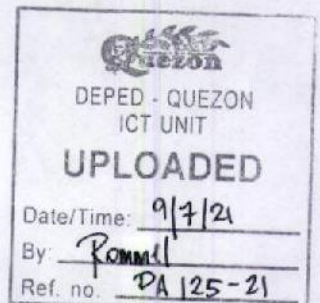

**33rd NATIONAL INVITATIONAL MATHEMATICAL CHALLENGE OF THE UNIVERSITY
OF THE PHILIPPINES LOS BAÑOS MATHEMATICAL SCIENCES SOCIETY**

The UPLB Mathematical Sciences Society (UP MASS), a duly recognized organization of the University of the Philippines Los Baños will be hosting the Southern Tagalog Invitational Mathematical Challenge (MATHEMATCH), an online quiz contest for high school students. With the goal of promoting deeper appreciation and wider application of mathematical sciences, on the competition's 33rd iteration, the Society is extending the competition nationwide.

The MATHEMATCH is open to all junior and high school students. Each school may be represented by a maximum of four students only. There is no entry or registration fee for this competition.

Interested participants should register through the provided Google Form link to secure their slots for the competition. The registration period shall start on September 13, 2021, 10:00 a.m. and will end on October 1, 2021, 11:59 p.m. Only a maximum of 60 participants will be accommodated, following a first come, first served basis. Additional instructions will be regularly provided to the qualified participants via email and/or Facebook updates.

Participation of public and private schools shall be subject to the no-disruption-of classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order (DO) No. 9, s. 2005 titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith, and the policy on off-campus activities stated in DO 66, s. 2017. This is also subject to the no-collection policy as stated in Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546 also known as An Act Prohibiting the Sale of Tickets and/or the Collection of Contributions for Whatever Project or Purpose from Students and Teachers of Public and Private Schools, Colleges and Universities (Ganzon Law).
