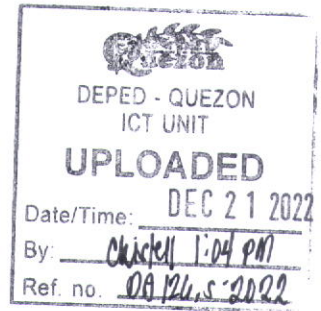

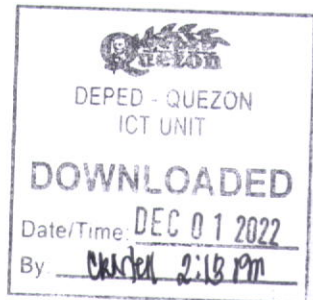

Aside from hosting leadership sessions, group dynamics, and team building sessions, the Institute also showcases the exceptional talents and skills of the youth through different contests such as:

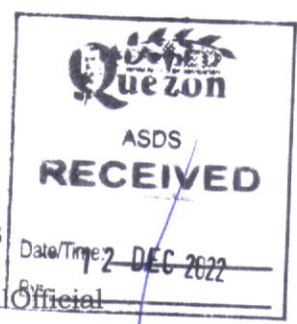
1. Essay Writing,
