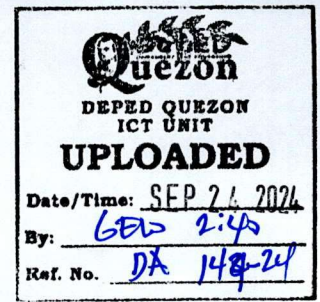

SUBJECT : 88TH CHARTER ANNIVERSARY OF THE BOY SCOUTS OF THE
PHILIPPINES AND 2024 NATIONAL SCOUTING MONTH

1. Pursuant to Commonwealth Act No. 111 as amended by the Republic Act No. 7278, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) will celebrate its 88th Charter Anniversary and 2024 National Scouting Month in October with the theme: **"BSP Elevate @88: Futureproofing Scouting for the Next Century and Beyond"**.
2. The purpose of the celebration is to showcase to the public and its stakeholders the contribution of the BSP to nation-building through the development of young people by actively engaging and supporting them to become agents of positive change in their respective communities. Specifically it aims to:

 - 2.4 foster camaraderie, promoting gender equality and inclusiveness among members as brothers and sisters in Scouting.
3. The BSP National Office will conduct several activities for the month of October 2024 which will be held at the various venues as indicated in the matrix of activities to be participated by BSP employees, NEB Officers and members, male and female Scouts and adult leaders from select local councils in the National Capital Region and nearby provinces of Metro Manila.
