
Dear Superintendents,

- d) strict observance of Time-On-Task Policy or the No Disruption of Classes Policy of the Department.







Greetings from the DA-Philippine Rice Research Institute (PhilRice) Los Baños!

DA-PhilRice, in collaboration with the Department of Agriculture, Department of Education, Department of Tourism - National Parks Development Committee, Bureau of Plant Industry, Asia Rice Foundation, and in cooperation with the City Government of Manila, established the Rice Garden at Rizal Park, Manila in 2001. The 300 square meter Rice Garden is a simulated field set-up showing actual rice plants of traditional and modern varieties grown in an irrigated ecosystem. It also showcases urban gardening through the growing of vegetables and other herbaceous plants in the periphery of the rice demo plots.

A Ceremonial Rice Harvesting is conducted annually in the Rice Garden during the National Rice Awareness Month (NRAM) every November. Hundreds of students and teachers from various primary and secondary schools in Metro Manila are invited for fun learning activities and to experience actual rice harvesting. Due to the current pandemic, the event will be virtually presented to the target participants, i.e., students and rice stakeholders, on November 25, 2021, 8:45AM, via Zoom and the DA-PhilRice Los Baños Facebook page. The activity aims to increase awareness of the general public about rice and rice-based products and their importance to Filipinos. Specifically, it aims to:

- Educate the youth on how they can help the rice industry by responsible rice consumption;
- 2. Increase awareness and knowledge of participants on the importance of rice as well as PhilRice's banner programs and campaigns; and
- 3. Promote a better appreciation and gratefulness to rice farmers for producing food despite various challenges.




