

The DRRM coordinators from regional offices, schools division offices, and schools are encouraged to participate in this event to further enhance their skills and knowledge in the field.



The National Association of Public Secondary Schools of the Philippines (NAPSSPHIL), Incorporated will hold a Training Sessions on Disaster Risk Reduction Management at La Carmela de Boracay, Malay Aklan on July 2-4, 2025

The activity aims to increase awareness of disaster risks within the school and community, equip participants with practical skills for effective disaster response, and foster collaboration among school and community members and local organizations. The Office of the DRRM, DepEd Central Office will facilitate the training sessions.

The target participants are DRRM coordinators from regional, division, elementary and secondary school offices and school heads. NAPSSPHIL Officers, Program Management Team, and members of the Technical Working Group are considered participants and are authorized to travel two days before and after the training. The participation of public-school personnel shall be subject to the no-disruption-of-classes policy as stipulated in DepEd Order (DO) No. 9, s. 2005 entitled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Task and ensuring compliance therewith.

A registration fee of seven thousand pesos (Php 7,000.00) shall be charged to each participant to cover expenses for meals and snacks, venue rental, honoraria for resource persons and facilitators, and other incidental expenses, chargeable against school MOOE and/or other local funds, subject to COA accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
