



Greetings from the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP)!

This has reference to your communication dated 02 May 2024, concerning the participation of teachers and school leaders in external professional development (PD) trainings provided by private organizations using their personal funds. In response to the issues and concerns you raised in your letter, please refer to the following clarifications:

Issues and Concerns	Clarification
Absence of clear mechanisms on NEAP authorization and recognition processes for external PD programs for teachers and school leaders	Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 12, s. 2023 titled Moratorium on the Implementation of DepEd Order No. 001, s. 2020 (Guidelines for NEAP Recognition of Professional Development Programs and Courses for Teachers and School Leaders), the NEAP Quality Assurance Division shall no longer
Formalizing a partnership with the Department in providing PD programs for teachers and school leaders	receive and process applications including renewal of authorization and recognition of PD programs. The moratorium shall remain in effect unless otherwise lifted by subsequent issuances.
	During the moratorium, all external learning service providers may continue to offer their PD programs and courses, subject to the voluntary participation of teachers and school leaders.
Absence of official advisory for external PD programs which causes apprehension among teachers due to uncertainty if these will help in their career progression	Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 044, s. 2023 titled Interim Guidelines for the Quality Assurance and Monitoring and Evaluation of the NEAP Core Programs, teachers and school leaders may participate in PD programs offered by external service providers on their own volition. It is for this reason that endorsements or issuance of DepEd advisories for the purpose shall no longer be made.
	As to career progression, the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Executive Order No. 174, s.

2022 titled Establishing the Expanded Career Progression System for Public School Teachers has yet to be issued. Thus, all relevant trainings attended by teachers can be considered in cases of promotion or career progression subject to evaluation and assessment in accordance with DepEd Order No. 19, s. 2022 titled Department of Education Merit Selection Plan and DepEd Order No. 007, s. 2023 titled Guidelines on Recruitment, Selection, and Appointment in the Department of Education.

On teachers using their personal funds to attend trainings offered by private training organizations Subject to their own volition and on a voluntary basis, teachers may attend PD training programs offered by external service providers using their own personal funds.
