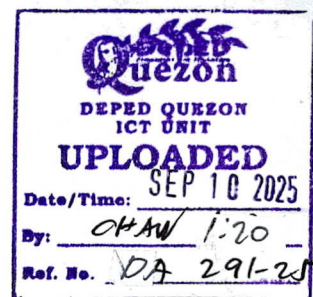

This activity is also subject to the no-collection policy as stated in Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546, also known as An Act Prohibiting the Sale of Tickets and/or the Collection of Contributions for Whatever Project or Purpose from Students and Teachers of Public and Private Schools, Colleges, and Universities (Ganzon Law), as reiterated in DepEd Order No. 19, s. 2008 and DepEd Memorandum No. 041, s. 2024.
