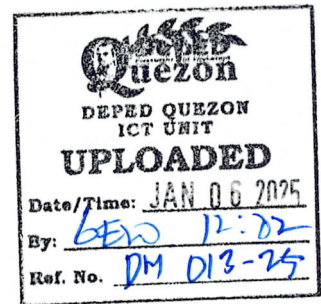

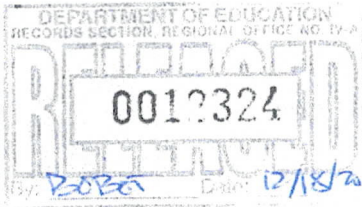

**REQUEST FOR DATA ON THE INVENTORY OF TEACHERS
HANDLING VALUES EDUCATION AND EDUKASYON SA
PAGPAPAKATAO**

To: **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. In reference to DepEd Order No. 55 s. 2013¹, DepEd Order No. 010, s. 2024² and DepEd Order No. 005, s. 2024³, this Office through the Field Technical Assistance Division requests to submit the data on the inventory of teachers handling Values Education and Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao.
2. In light of the ongoing challenge regarding child protection and bullying within the schools in CALABARZON and despite the numerous initiatives implemented, there has been a continuous increase in the number of cases. To address this urgent issue effectively, the Schools Division Office (SDO) must strengthen the educational framework, particularly in Values Education (VE) and Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP). The teachers handling these subjects must demonstrate mastery of the subject matter and/or their specialization across the curriculum.
3. The schools through the SDO are directed to submit an inventory of teachers specializing in VE and EsP that shall include the teachers' names, qualifications and specializations, current teaching assignments, and any relevant training in child protection and bullying prevention.
4. In line with the pressing issue, the SDO is directed to review the class programming and teachers load and inventory of allocated items who possess a major in VE or EsP. This targeted approach aims to enhance the expertise and specialization within the teaching staff in handling these important subject areas.

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
