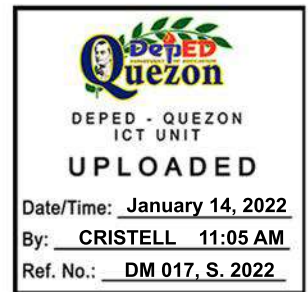

SCHOOL CALENDAR ADJUSTMENT IN CALABARZON TO FOSTER ACADEMIC EASE

To **All Schools Division Superintendents**

1. In support to the provisions of DM-CI-2022-009 and OUCI-2020-307 and the region's initiative for safe operations and well-being of stakeholders as contained in the Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan, this Office announces the suspension of classes in all grade levels on January 17 - 29, 2022. This suspension includes all other school activities, whether physical or virtual (online), that involve school-based personnel, learners, and parents.
2. The schedule of midyear break on January 31 – February 5, 2022, shall remain as stipulated in DO 29, s. 2021.
3. Schools Division Offices are encouraged to do necessary adjustments in the implementation of the curriculum after these suspension dates particularly when new directives are issued.
4. Private schools, in consultation with their respective parents' associations, may exercise their own discretion relative to the suspension of classes and K to 12 learning activities when COVID-19 risks in their respective areas are high.
5. Immediate implementation of and strict compliance to this Memorandum is directed.
