- 3. The services rendered by SBFP Core Group beyond regular functions/ work hours/ days in relation to the implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program are eligible for service credits in accordance with the provisions of DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003, the Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credit to Teachers. The School Heads are responsible for requesting such Service Credits for approval by the Schools Division Superintendent.

RESUMPTION AND OBSERVANCE OF THE HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS DURING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM

To Schools Division Superintendents

- Pursuant to DepEd Order 31, s. 2021 entitled OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM, all schools are hereby directed to strictly observe the Health and Safety Protocols during the implementation of the school-Based Feeding Program.
- 2. The School-Based Feeding Program shall continue even under Alert Level 3 and is not covered by the restrictions from the IATF but expected to strictly observe the minimum public health standards. Attached are the activities characterized as high-risk for transmission which shall not be allowed to operate or be undertaken in areas classified under Alert Level 3 by the IATF (Enclosure C) for reference.
- 3. In lieu of the resumption of the SBFP, Health and Safety Checklist for the School-Based Feeding Program is hereby being issued to ensure the health and safety of the personnel involved during the implementation of SBFP. Attached are the Health and Safety Checklist (Enclosure A) and the Health and Safety reminders for the implementers of the SBFP (Enclosure B) for reference.
- 4. For the health and welfare of the personnel involved in the implementation of the SBFP and as stipulated in DepEd Order 31 s. 2021, excess funds for the SBFP may be used for the procurement of multivitamins/Vitamin C for the implementers in the school.
- 5. The School Feeding Coordinators may file and request for Service Credits in coordination with the Division School-Based Feeding Program Coordinator for the conduct activities and tasks beyond regular functions or beyond regular work hours/days in relation to the implementation of the school-Based Feeding Program for approval of the Schools Division Superintendent as per DepEd Order 53 s. 2003.
