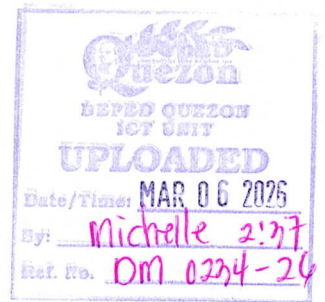

In reference to the letter of the Department of Agriculture (DA) addressed to the Department of Education (DepEd) Secretary, this Office hereby directs all field offices to extend full support and coordination to the initiatives of the DA-Bureau of Plant Industry (BPI) relative to the implementation of the *Gulayan sa Paaralan Program* (GPP), copy attached.

The DA-BPI, through its Crop Research and Production Support Division (CRPSD) and the National Urban and Peri-Urban Agriculture Program (NUPAP), plays a vital role in advancing the urban agriculture food system through the implementation of community-based farming initiatives. The Bureau actively promotes the establishment of school gardens and distributes quality planting materials, particularly during the conduct of *Brigada Eskwela* and related capacity-building activities.

From 2024 to date, the DA-BPI has supported 259 schools in the National Capital Region and adjacent regions through the distribution of 20,325 packets of seeds and 11,370 seedlings, the establishment of 62 school gardens nationwide, and the conduct of 23 training sessions. These initiatives are designed not only to promote food production but also to cultivate resilience, sustainability, and civic responsibility among learners and youth.
