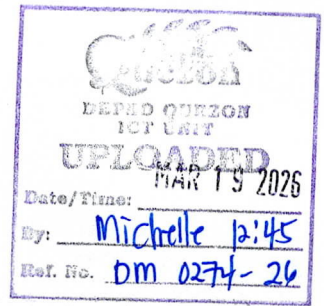

**DIVISION MEMORANDUM**

**DIVISION-WIDE COMPLIANCE MONITORING ON THE PROHIBITION OF COLLECTION OF CONTRIBUTIONS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS (RA 4206, AS AMENDED BY RA 5546)**

**To:** Assistant Schools Division Superintendents  
 Division Chiefs  
 Public Schools District Supervisors  
 Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads  
 All Others Concerned

1. Pursuant to **Republic Act No. 4206**, as amended by **Republic Act No. 5546**, which strictly prohibits the collection of any form of contributions from learners in public schools, and as reiterated in **Regional Memorandum No. 157, s. 2026** titled Reiteration of PTA Fund Raising and No Collection Policy in Schools, this Office informs all concerned of the conduct of a **Division-Wide Compliance Monitoring** on the implementation of the said policy.
2. The monitoring aims to assess the level of compliance of all public elementary and secondary schools with the provisions of the aforementioned laws, particularly on the non-imposition of mandatory contributions and the proper handling of voluntary contributions, if any.
3. In line with this, **all public schools** are directed to accomplish the **Division Compliance Monitoring Survey** through the link provided below:

5. A separate Memorandum shall be issued outlining the full guidelines on the Division's monitoring mechanisms for the implementation of the said policy.
6. The data gathered shall serve as the basis for the provision of appropriate technical assistance, policy reinforcement, and other necessary interventions to ensure full compliance across all schools.
7. **Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDSs)** shall ensure the compliance of all schools within their respective jurisdictions in the accomplishment of the said monitoring survey within the prescribed timeline.
8. Immediate and strict compliance with this Memorandum is directed.

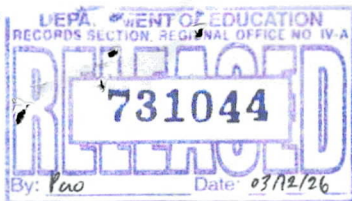

**REITERATION OF PTA FUND RAISING AND  
"NO COLLECTION POLICY" IN SCHOOLS**

To **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. Pursuant to Section 1, RA 4206<sup>1</sup>, and as amended by RA 5546<sup>2</sup>, it is hereby reiterated that the sale of tickets and/or the collection of contributions in any form whatsoever, by any person for any project or purpose, whether voluntary or otherwise, from school children, students, and teachers of public and private schools, colleges, and universities, is hereby prohibited. Provided, however, that this prohibition shall not cover membership fees of school children and students of the Red Cross, the Girl Scouts of the Philippines, and the Boy Scouts of the Philippines. Provided, finally, that this prohibition shall not cover the contributions of parents and other donors for the support of barrio high schools.
2. It is emphasized, however, that PTA fund-raising activities are not considered as compulsory contributions even if these were discussed and agreed in Parents' Forum, to preclude the impression of using coercive influence, and teachers must not be involved themselves in the collection or act as collecting agents.
3. Section 2, RA 4206 as amended, provides that non-compliance with the aforementioned prohibition shall be penalized with a fine or by imprisonment for not less than one month or both in the discretion of the court.
4. All previous issuances that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
5. All Schools Division Offices are instructed to establish their respective monitoring mechanism and ensure continuing compliance of schools with the aforementioned Department issuances.
